

DESCRIPTION: (continued)

The house is T-shaped with an intersecting gable roof. Windows are slightly arched with stone sills. A screened porch has been added to the northwest corner and dormers have been added to the southeast and west. The barn is located just southwest of the house and is built into the hillside. Walls are solid stone from the foundation to the roof line. Several arched window and door openings are on the south facade and two small arched windows on the east. A pair of large sliding barn doors open onto the top of the hill on the north facade. Two ventilators cap the low-pitched gable roof. The owners are presently restoring the barn. The garage to the west and the horsebarn to the north are of recent construction.

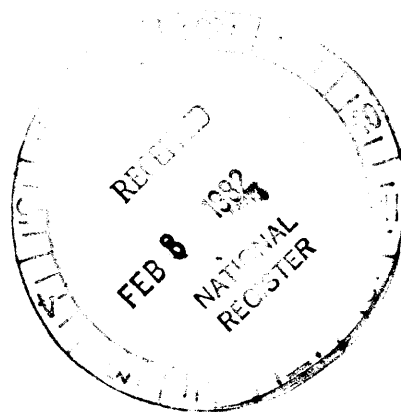
