VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A in the W corner of the yard on Curtis Road, thence 380 ft N to B in the corner of the yard, thence 160 ft west fence to C at the top of the bank, thence along edge of bank to D at Curtis Road, thence with road to the beginning, containing the stone house, lawn, shed and garage. Barns on farm are later. 1 1/3 acre
