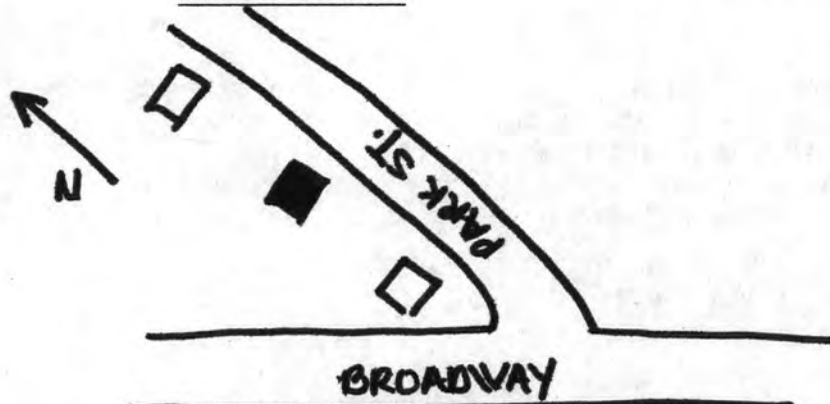

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE (Describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other buildings within the community.)

10 Park Street is among the best remaining examples of the late Italianate style in Methuen. Constructed ca.1880, it is a 2½-story clapboard-clad house enclosed by a pitched roof. A two-story tripartite bay and bracketed entrance hood are the principal features of the facade. A round-arch window in the gable end lights the attic. Windows at the first and second story have projecting lintels and contain 2/2 sash.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE (Explain the role owners played in local or state history and how the building relates to the development of the community.)

10 Park Street possesses integrity of location, design, setting, materials and workmanship. It is a well preserved Italianate style house, associated with the development of Methuen during the post-war expansion of local mills and the nearby Lawrence area. E. M. Clark, an early resident, listed his occupation as a shoe manufacturer. 10 Park Street meets criterion C of the National Register of Historic Places.

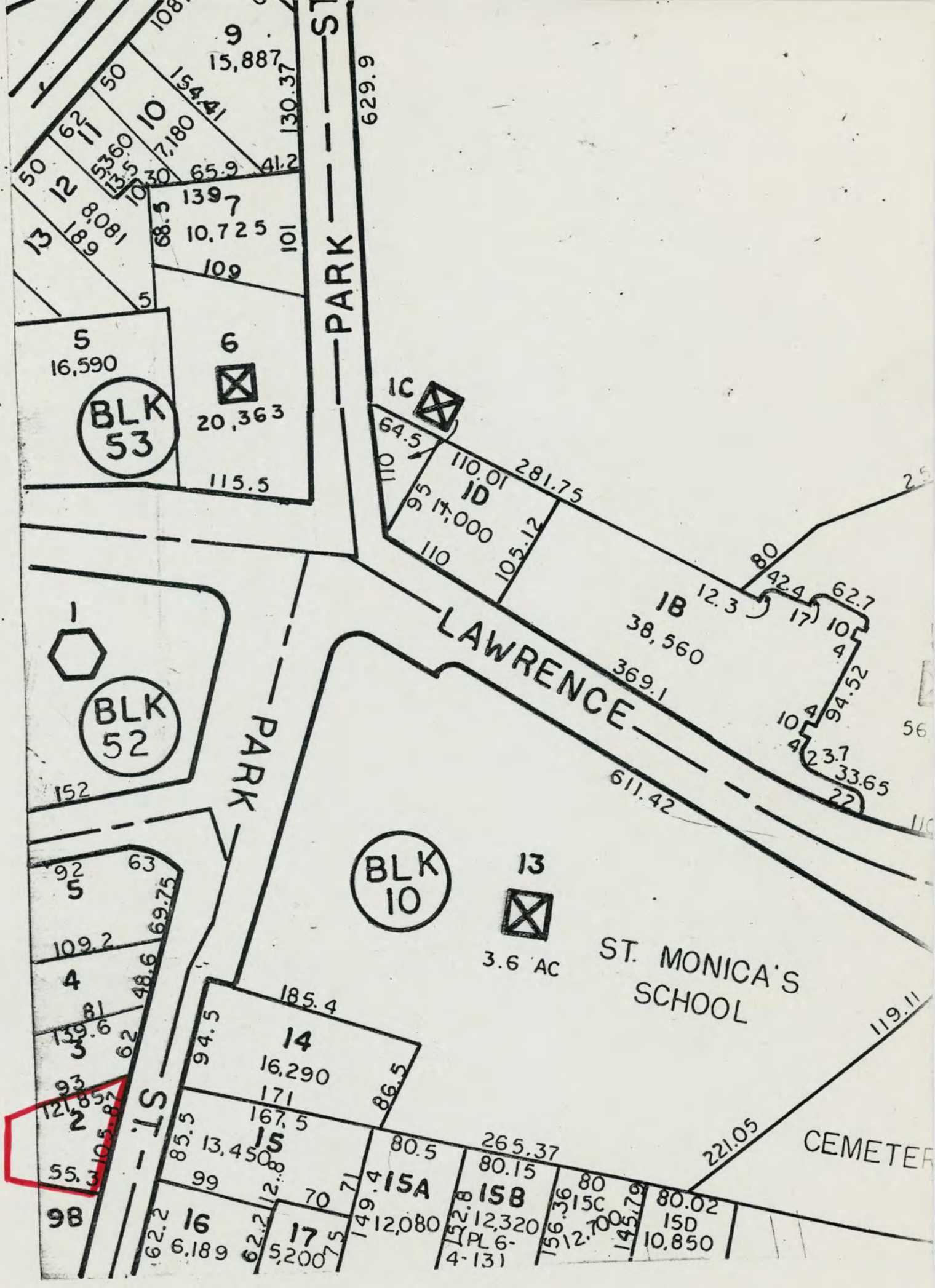
