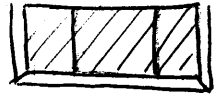

7 stone ashlar massives, interior end chimneys, fine original dentilled cornice, (photo 5)  
pegged frames, ovolo trim, nosed sills.

(photo 6) Interior had corner stairs in rear end corner of each room. Has double faced trim, 6 panel doors, mantels w eared architraves, (unique feature) (photo 7)  
correct and rarely surviving 3 stone hearths, =  
chair rail upstairs. Some doors changed.



The roof of the kitchen wing includes the old front porch now part of the room. (photo 2)

Has interior end chimney, 1 attic window.

A stone pantry w cellar below has shed roof (photo 3)  
added to ridge of kitchen roof.

The G.R. house on the S end of the stone (photo 4)  
house is 2 stories, 5 bays, central hall & house  
built in 1834. Heavy G.R. mantels. Stair  
has open stringer, square balusters, turned  
slender newell (Federal type). An enclosed 2 story  
porch was built spanning rear of stone house,  
providing passage from center hall to W stone hse.  
room & kitchen beyond. Front porch here and (photo 1)  
on stone house built same time.

The stone house was built facing a spring and  
branch of Clear Creek. The G.R. house faces the  
Keane Pike at 69. The yard is partially surrounded  
by a rock fence, barn, and contains an early  
single cell 1 1/2 story stone slave quarters. (photo 8)

VERBAL BOUNDARY DESCRIPTION & JUSTIFICATION

Beginning at A on the road (196). thence <sup>N</sup> along fence 680 ft to B, thence E with fence and around barn 190 ft to C, thence S along fence 680 ft to D at road, thence W with road to the beginning, containing the house, additions, quarters, barn & rock fence. No other buildings on site. 3 acres
