The Ruggles House is unlike other four square houses in that it is only one room deep. The two story building is not extremely large, but has some truly outstanding architectural features.

The most distinctive feature of the house is the "Flying" staircase which rises from the front hall, then divides into two reverse stairs without lateral support. Mantles and other interior wood finish were carved. Much of the fine work was completed with a pen knife, including the rope beading on the cornices of the fireplace and a swastika design below the mantle in the dining room.

The elaborate carvings are over ornate, but this was typical of the architecture of the time of the Ruggles House construction. The doorway that opens into the front hall is an example of the change that was in progress when builders were going from the Georgian to the neo-classic style of architecture.

The home has lovely fluting on the window sills, and delicately carved cornices around the eaves. This is all fine handwork, not jig saw gingerbreading.

Before restoration work commenced in 1938, the house was badly in need of repair. Due to restoration projects, the Ruggles House is at present considered to be in excellent condition.

Originally an ell containing a kitchen, dining room and three bedrooms was connected to the home. When restoration work was initiated Society members decided that the ell would not be reconstructed due to its poor condition.
