

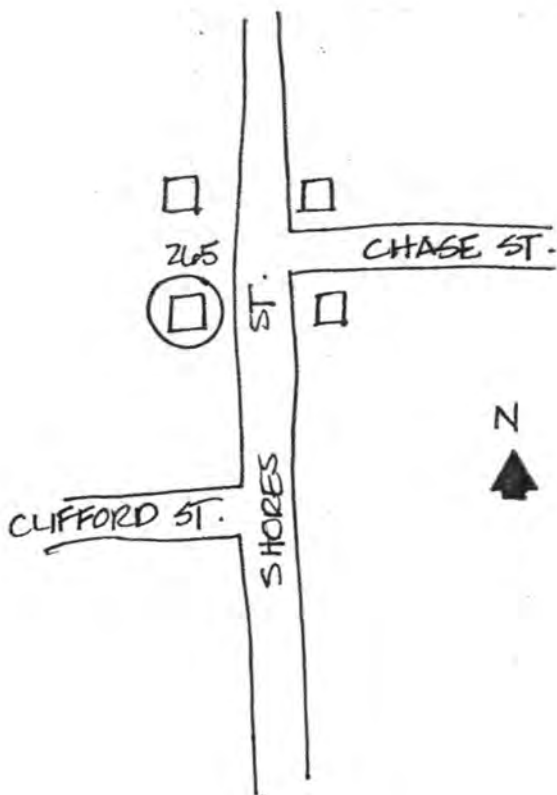

9. Historical significance (include explanation of themes checked above)

Although it has been altered, this house is an extremely rare example of Gambrel-roofed construction, found in only a small percentage of Southeastern Massachusetts houses. Its appearance on a 1728 map would make it one of the oldest standing structures in the city.

Description: The gambrel-roofed, 1½-story structure features very small window openings, and a central, wood plank door, framed by narrow sidelights. Its roof is broken by a central chimney (rebuilt), and has close-cropped eaves.

The Job Knapp House possesses integrity of design, location, setting, materials, workmanship and association. It meets criterion C of the National Register of Historic Places. Its significance derives primarily from its overall retention of the gambrel roof cottage form in a house of this period, few of which survive today in Taunton.

Boundaries conform to current lot lines.

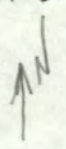
