| 19 History<br>William Miller came to Kentucky in 1775 and helped Boone cut wilderness. Denny was son-in-law of Lt. Wm. Miller, who allegedly deserted his companions in the Battle of Little Mountain (Estell's Defeat) in 1782. Miller was original owner of property, Denny built house in 1850 and served as State Senator from Garrard County 1859-63. Garrard County's best example of a brick Greek Revival residence with outbuildings. House is on site of the original Paint Lick Station established in 1775. |  | 17. 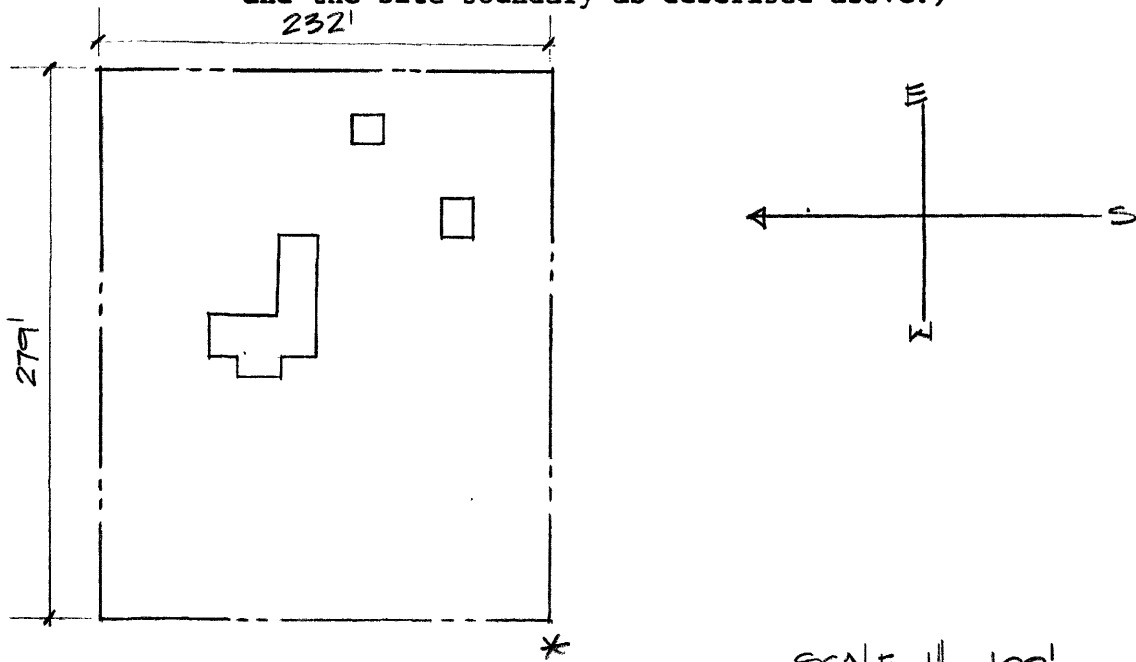
