DESCRIPTION

SUMMARY

The Leneer Fish Cabin at Captiva Rocks contributes to the Fish Cabins of Charlotte Harbor Multiple Property Group under Associated Property Type: Fish Cabins of Charlotte Harbor, c. 1920 - 1941. It is an example of the sub-type, Residential Cabins. Located in Pine Island Sound on the south side of Charlotte Harbor, it is a one story, wood frame vernacular building set on wood pilings over the water. Built circa 1920, the building has a corrugated metal gable roof, wood siding, a dock and a porch.

DESCRIPTIVE STATEMENT

The Leneer Fish Cabin at Captiva Rocks was built circa 1920 by the Punta Gorda Fish Company. A one story wood frame vernacular building, it is set on wood pilings over the water at Captiva Rocks shoal in Pine Island Sound, which is on the south side of Charlotte Harbor. The building has a corrugated metal gable roof and is clad in wood siding. A dock and porch are located on the eastern side of the building. (Photo 1)

The Leneer Fish Cabin is one of the oldest stilt buildings at the Captiva Rocks camp. The original board and batten siding is intact beneath the current siding and the original shingle roof is intact beneath the present tin roof. The form and configuration of the building and of its windows and doors are original. (Photos 2-3) Beaded tongue and groove siding on the interior dates to the original construction.

SIGNIFICANCE

SUMMARY

The Leneer Fish Cabin at Captiva Rocks is significant at the state level under Criterion A for its association with the pre-World War II commercial fishing industry in Charlotte Harbor. The building contributes to the Fish Cabins of Charlotte Harbor Multiple Property Group under Associated Historic Contexts: Commercial Fishing Industry of Charlotte Harbor, c. 1920 - 1941, and Associated Property Type: Fish Cabins of Charlotte Harbor, c. 1920 - 1941. It is an example of the sub-type, Residential Cabins.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE

The Leneer Fish Cabin at Captiva Rocks is associated with events significant to the history of the Charlotte Harbor commercial fishing industry, one of the largest fishing operations in Florida before World War II. The Leneer Fish Cabin is one of the oldest stilt buildings at Captiva Rocks. Like the other residential fish cabins, the building provided a home away from home for fishermen who were on extended fishing expeditions. This allowed the fishermen to stay in the vicinity of the fishing grounds, rather than travel long distances to their homes on the mainland.

The fish camp buildings of Pine Island Sound, where this cabin is located, were constructed in the early 20th century by the Punta Gorda Fish Company. The company built a series of stilt houses throughout Charlotte Harbor and Pine Island Sound. The buildings were used as residences for fishermen, ice houses, and served assorted functions related to the fishing industry such as the mooring of skiffs, drying and cleaning of nets and the storage of fishing equipment.

This residential fish cabin represents a specialized form of architecture designed to meet the specific needs of the fishing industry. Built on pilings above the water, it is made of simple, available materials that could be transported to the site for construction. The cabin can be lifted off its pilings and moved to more abundant fishing grounds, if necessary. While strictly vernacular in form, it is constructed of the most durable materials available, that of heart pine and cypress, in order to withstand climatic extremes.
