Semi-flush brick end chimneys-cut stone foundation. Bulls eye corner blocks flanking wood lintels on main facade are often details. 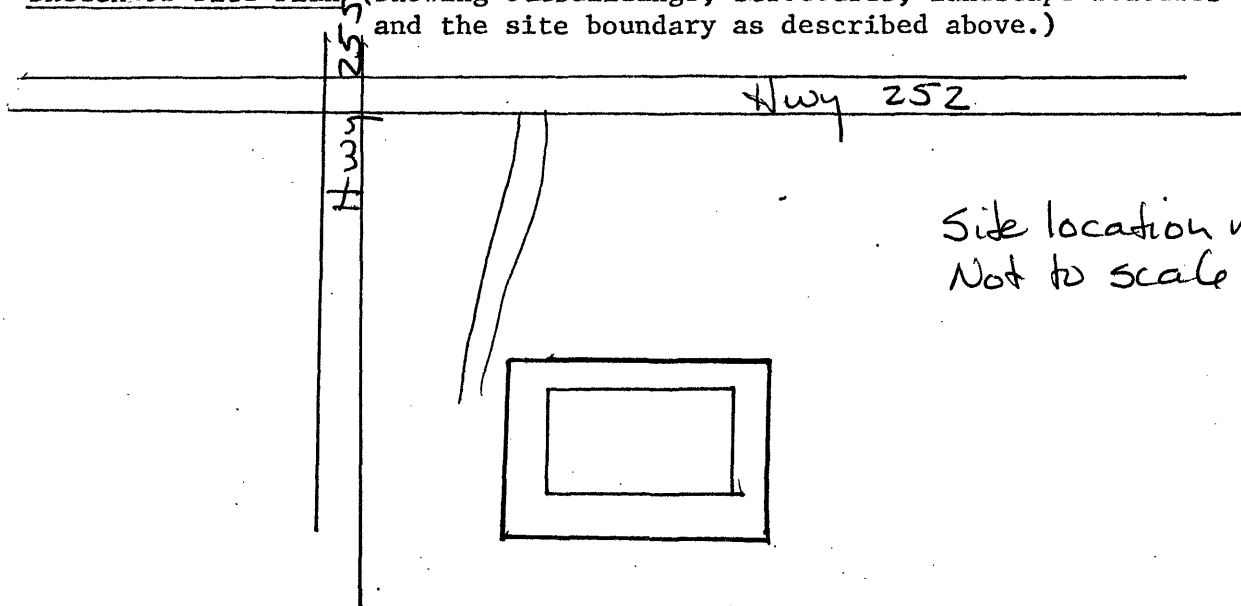

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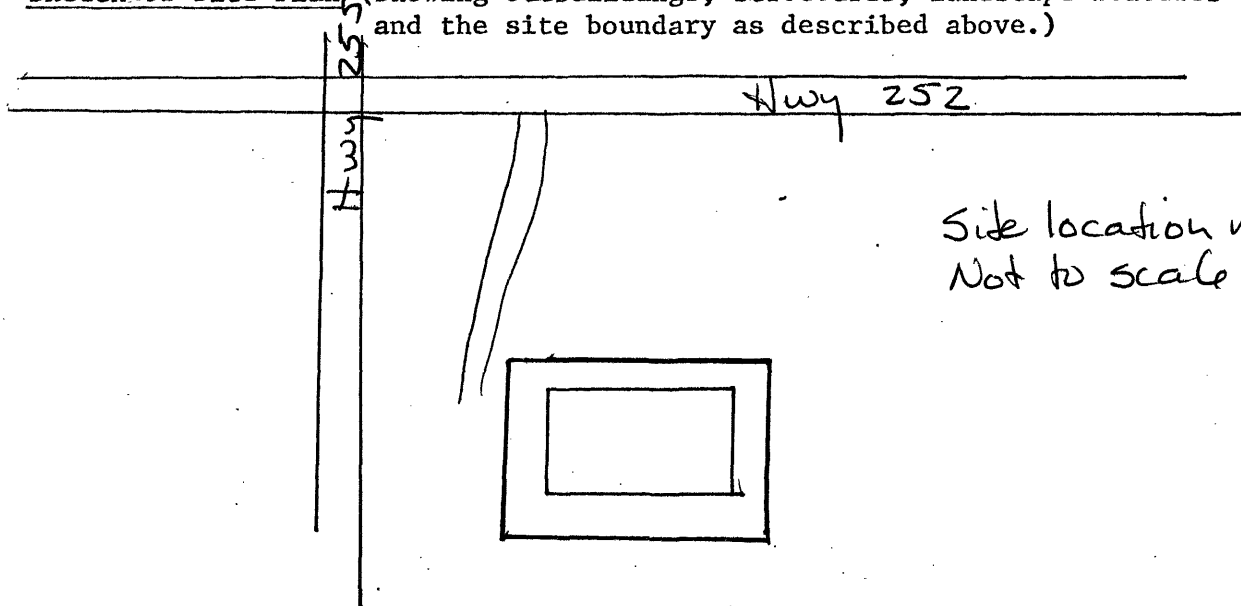
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
