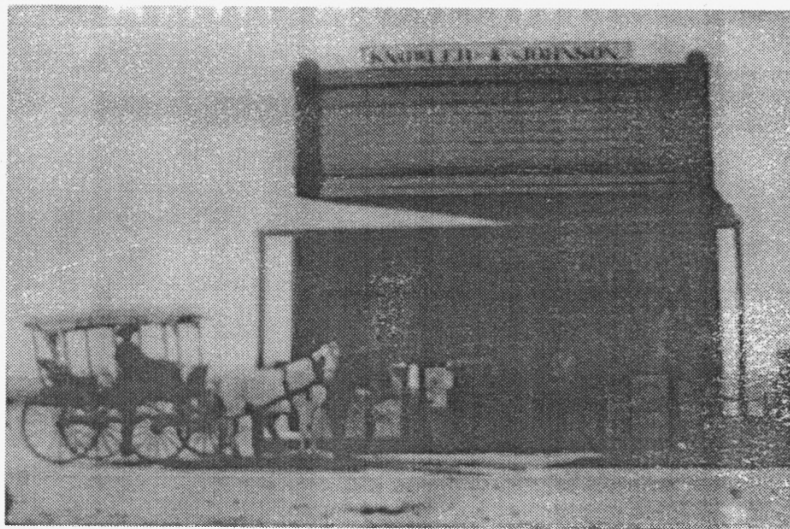

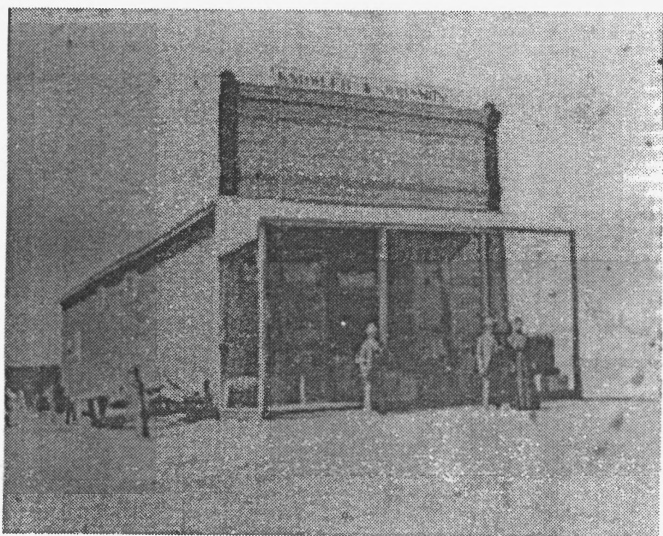

Historic Photo of the Knowler & Johnson Store (now Bonita Store), c. 1885 showing the brick-pattereded tarpaper siding.



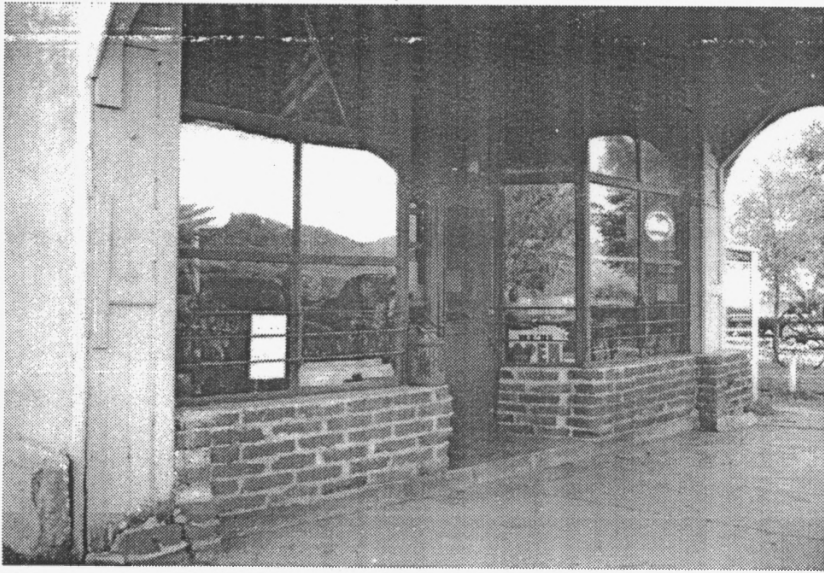

The storefront windows and entry doors are virtually unchanged since built in 1882. The concrete step and masonry veneer were added in the 1960s.
