DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This building, the second Ringgold County Jail, was built in 1895. It is a two-story, side gable structure with exterior walls of brick on a random ashlar foundation. Dimensions are approximately $38' \times 27'$.

Front and rear elevations are nearly identical. The east half of each facade has two yery tall windows with segmental arched tops (marking the original cellblock). The west half, which originally contained an office, bath and juvenile cells, has shorter windows on both floors. There are two windows at first floor level on the east end, one on the west end, and small louvred openings in the attic story on both ends.

The side walls originally culminated in shallow shoulder parapets. Remains of a brick chimney are found toward the south end. Decorative elements are confined to a narrow beltcourse of raised brick at the level of the second floor window heads, and corbelling just beneath the eaves on the front and rear elevations.

Besides the loss of the end parapets, exterior alterations are limited to removal of the bars on the windows, and replacement, in brick and corrugated metal, of the original small wooden entrance porch.

The steel cells and other jail accourrements have long since been removed. The building was sold to the local American Legion post following completion of the fourth county courthouse (which included a new jail) in 1927. The present owners plan to use the building as an art studio, and have given some thought to replacing the original end parapets.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

This building is locally significant as an artifact of Ringgold County's government architecture. The original jail, and first three courthouses, are no longer extant. Generally speaking, it was the custom to tear down obsolete county facilities as new ones were erected. Thus those that remain from earlier periods of a county's history have a certain cultural value.

Ringgold County was not settled until about 1855, when the county was formally organized. Mount Ayr was established as the county seat in that year; but until the railroad arrived in 1879, the town grew but slowly. The first county government facility was a log courthouse, erected in 1856. A frame courthouse was built in 1859, replaced in 1882 with a brick, vaguely Gothic Revival structure. The first county jail was built in 1876: a log building with a metal roof. The second jail (the subject of this nomination) was built in 1895 by a local brickmason, James McCombs. The basic design of the building, and the steel cells, were supplied by the Pauly Jail Building and Manufacturing Co. of St. Louis. When the fourth courthouse was completed in 1927, it included correctional facilities, so the 1895 jail was sold. The local American Legion post occupied the building until 1978.
