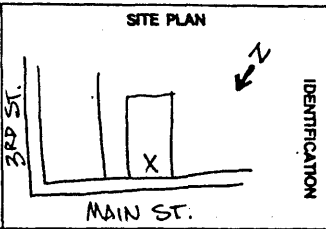

E. Newspaper reports suggest that ever-versatile architect Frank J. Schlotter was probably the designer of this Art Nouveau building in about 1910. Actually, a substantial remodeling of a much earlier building (possibly 1860s), the new structure was occupied under a lease agreement with Edward N. Hill, operator of a "new clothing and gents furnishings store."
