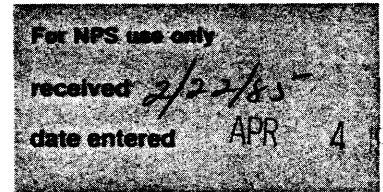

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#109 Blanton Log House

111. 64, 50' E of La Puente Road and 230 yards S of Hatchery Road.

4. Owner: Marshall and Dorothy Blanton, P.O. Box 152, Parkview, NM 87551

7. Description: foundation unknown; some mud plaster over horizontal log with dovetail notched walls, one set of half dovetail splices; corrugated metal gable roof, extremely steep; vertical planks and doors in both gable ends; 2/2, 4/4 double hung windows; 3 single doors 2-N, 1-S; interior rafters 2 by 6's with beaded corners; chamfered porch posts. Large opening cut into one of short ends and interior partitions removed for conversion to use as garage/storage shed. The building is composed of a gable-roofed rectangle, c. 45' by 15', with a shed-roofed addition, c. 20' by 10', on the SW corner.

Located beside the La Puente Road and adjacent to the Becker complex, just above the drop-off from the first plateau to the river.

8. Significance: This is a well-preserved, slightly-modified example of Hispanic log housing. The dovetail notching, half dovetail joints and steep roof are somewhat unusual. The linear, modular composition, multiple doors and gable doors are typical.

10. Acreage: under 1. UTM Ref: 13 358830 4064740

Boundary: A rectangle, roughly 65' by 40', formed by a line ten feet outside the building.
