

#### Physical Description

Located on a small corner lot on a busy thoroughfare, a striking temple front with an Ionic hexastyle portico dominates the design of this otherwise simple red-brick church of modest size designed by Charles Thompson. Elevated on a high brick foundation, the church is approached by a wide group of stairs, encased by brick piers capped with cast stone coping. In keeping with the modest scale and size of the church, decoration is at a minimum. The Ionic columns, which rest on Attic bases, are unfluted and the entablature is unembellished. The double-leaf entrance is crowned by multi-paned transoms. Two large, multi-paned windows flank the door. Appearing over a simple cast stone molding at auditorium balcony level are three smaller windows with similar multi-paned windows in which mullions are arranged like spokes radiating from the center. The sides of the church have five bays separated by shallow brick piers which rest on cast stone watertable. Two large multi-paned windows appear in the bay nearest the entrance; subsequent bays feature large stained-glass windows in predominantly green and gold tones.

#### Statement of Significance

The church at 3323 West 12th in Little Rock is architecturally significant in its finely detailed Classical Revival design. The building was designed ca. 1925 by Charles L. Thompson in a then outlying area of town. Now a major street in Little Rock, the semi-commercial location of the building only serves to create a setting in which it is a landmark structure. The attractive temple front of the church features an Ionic hexastyle portico. The simplicity of the design is accentuated by the classical details on the portico. The elegant church is of red brick construction and is elevated on a high brick foundation. The classical influence in the design of this church varies from Thompson's fendency to utilize Gothic details in church design. This design features the only use of a monumental temple front portico for a church in the collection of drawings.
