A simple Classical front in buff brick with a Greek key cornice on consoles and a 2nd story inset with 4 fluted columns in antis supporting a straight cornice, as well as a later tiled 1st story and marquee, mask a severely simple red brick building.

A simple Classical front in built brick with a Greek key cornice on Consoles and a 2nd story inset with 4 fluted columns in antia supporting a straight cornice, as well as a later tiled lat story and margore, mask a severaly simple red brick building.
