NATIONAL REGISTER CRITERIA STATEMENT (if applicable)

The Captain Thomas Gray House possesses integrity of location, design, setting, materials, workmanship, feeling and association. It is significant as a fine and locally rare example of the Stick Style that retains even its carriage barn. The property thus meets criterion C. of the National Register of Historic Places.

ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE Describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other buildings within the community.

The Capt. Thomas Gray House is a rare local example of the Stick Style, characterized by incised stick work in the numerous gables and by bold stylized pediments over many windows. It is enhanced by retention of its handsome large barn with cupola. The house rises two stories to a hip roof with numerous cross gables, enlivening its basic T-shaped plan. A one story porch, with simple brackets and squared posts, wraps around the front of the house abutting the arms of the T. The eastern arm has a two story, three sided bay terminating in a conical cap.

HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE Explain the role owners played in local or state history and how the building relates to the development of the community.

Captain Thomas Gray is noted as a captain of steam ships.

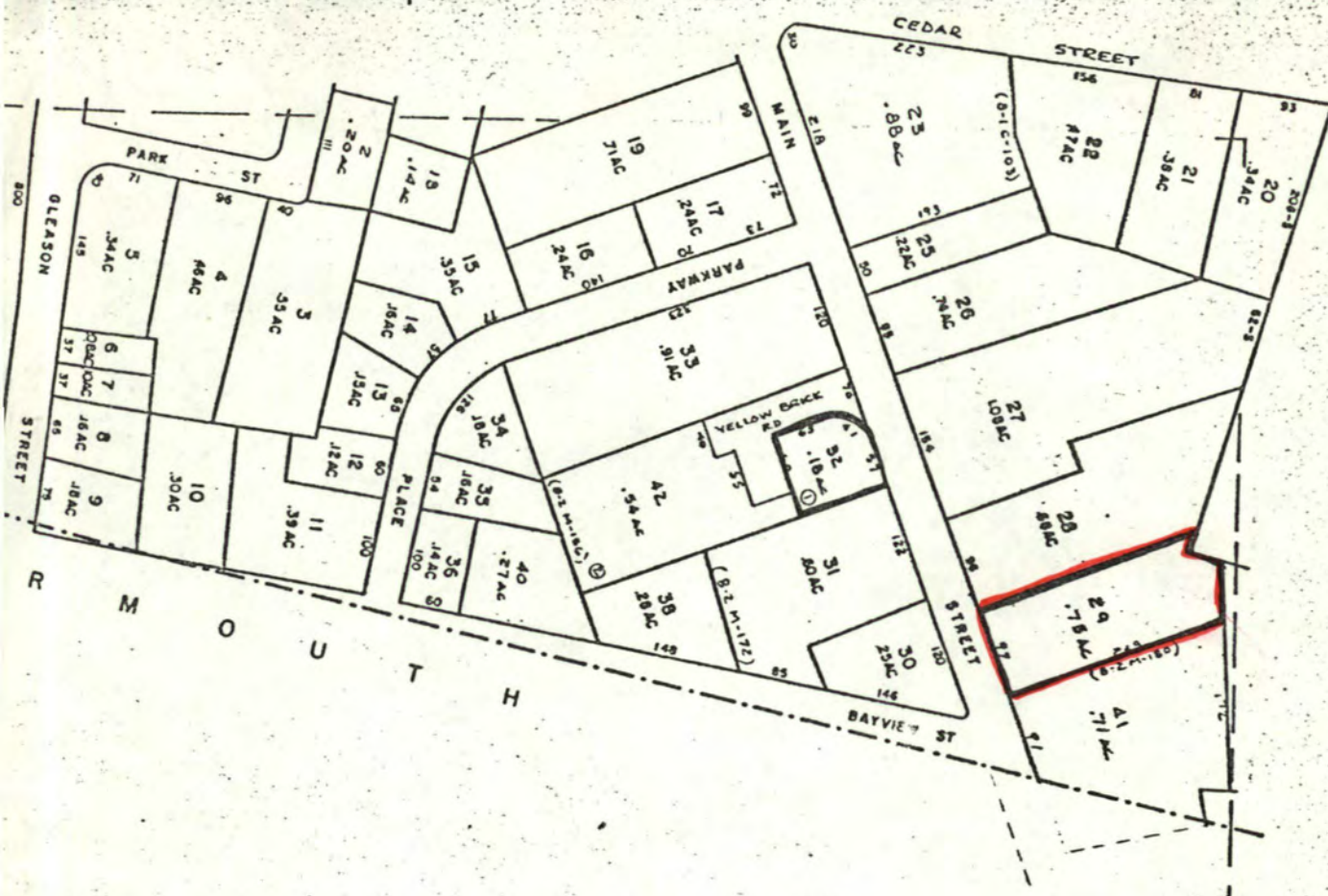
