
Section number 7 Tumon Pillbox III(66-01-1207)

The Tumon Pillbox III is presently situated about 50.0m inland from the high tide line, on property along Tumon Bay which has been developed for a zoo. It has been moved from its original location to a spot about 30.0m to the west. The structure, built of steel-reinforced concrete, is in excellent condition. Its original orientation is unknown.

The structure was built on a base which extends a distance of .10m beyond the exterior walls in each direction. The base is .25m thick. The base forms a cement floor for the interior. The exterior height of the structure from the base to the top of the roof is 1.95m. The interior height is 1.60m.

The structure has six walls which measure about .32m thick. Three of the walls have gun slits. The slits are located 1.20m above the floor. The exterior openings of the gun slits measure .37m by .10m. Two walls are solid. The entrance, about .60m wide and 1.22m high, is in the long wall.

Both horizontal and verticle impressions of the boards used to build the form into which the cement was poured are apparent on the exterior surface of the structure. Three eterior walls have horizontal impressions and three walls have verticle impressions. Impressions on the interior walls are horizontal.
