18. Description The Fisher Homestead is a Federal style dwelling situated on a rise overlooking the Cloverport-Hardinsburg Road (U.S. 60). Constructed ca. 1801, the one and one-half story brick structure with one-story brick ell was executed in common bond brickwork with a row of headers every five rows. 18. pane with jack arches and the main entrance is enhanced by a twelve pane fanlight with semi-circular arch. Interior and exterior gable-end chimneys with two quarter gable windows of 13-pane on each side set off the main block which rests on a limestone foundation. A four window dormer further accentuates the facade, and cornice with returns complete the structure. A unique architectural feature is the double window placement with two-pane sidelights and accented by an intricate Peacock fanlight with semi-circular arch found on the ell. A tile roof manufactured by the Murray Tile Company of Cloverport covers the structure. Behind the house is a single-story brick smokehouse done in common bond, and a one and one-half story frame barn.

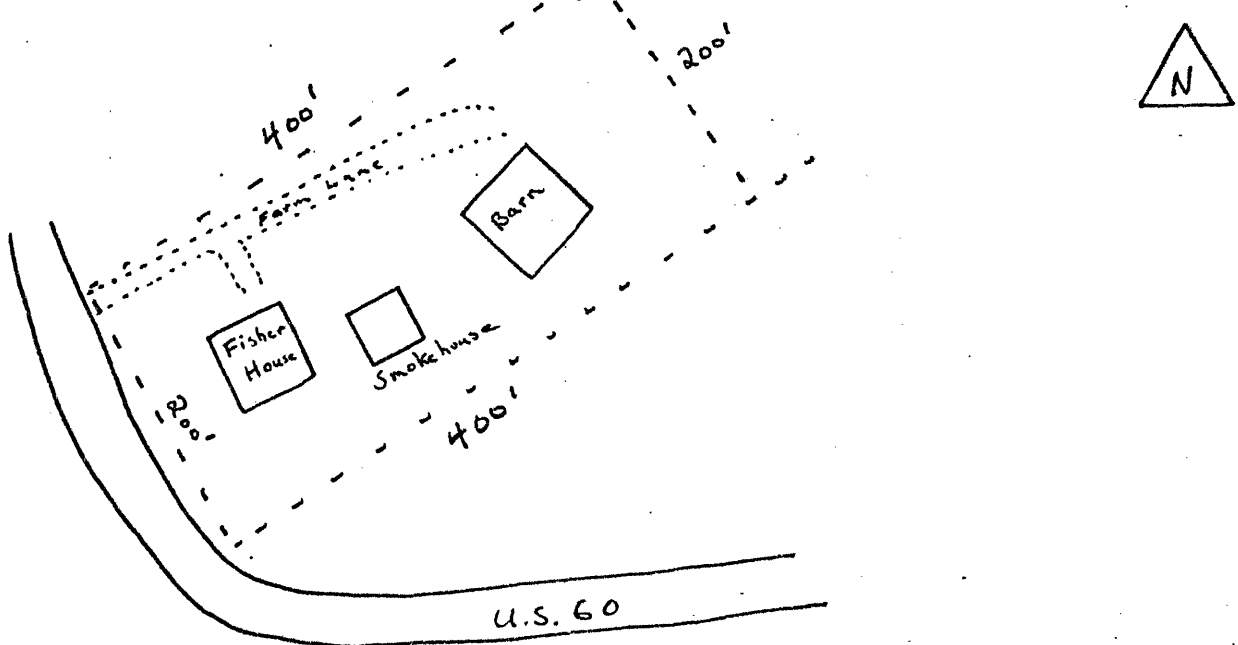

Beginning at the intersection of the farm lane and the east side of U.S. 60, approximately one hundred feet from the house, proceed 400 feet in a north eastward direction; thence 200 feet in a southeastward direction; thence 400 feet in a southwestward direction; thence 200 feet in a northwestward direction to the point of origin. The boundary is drawn to include the house and out-buildings.

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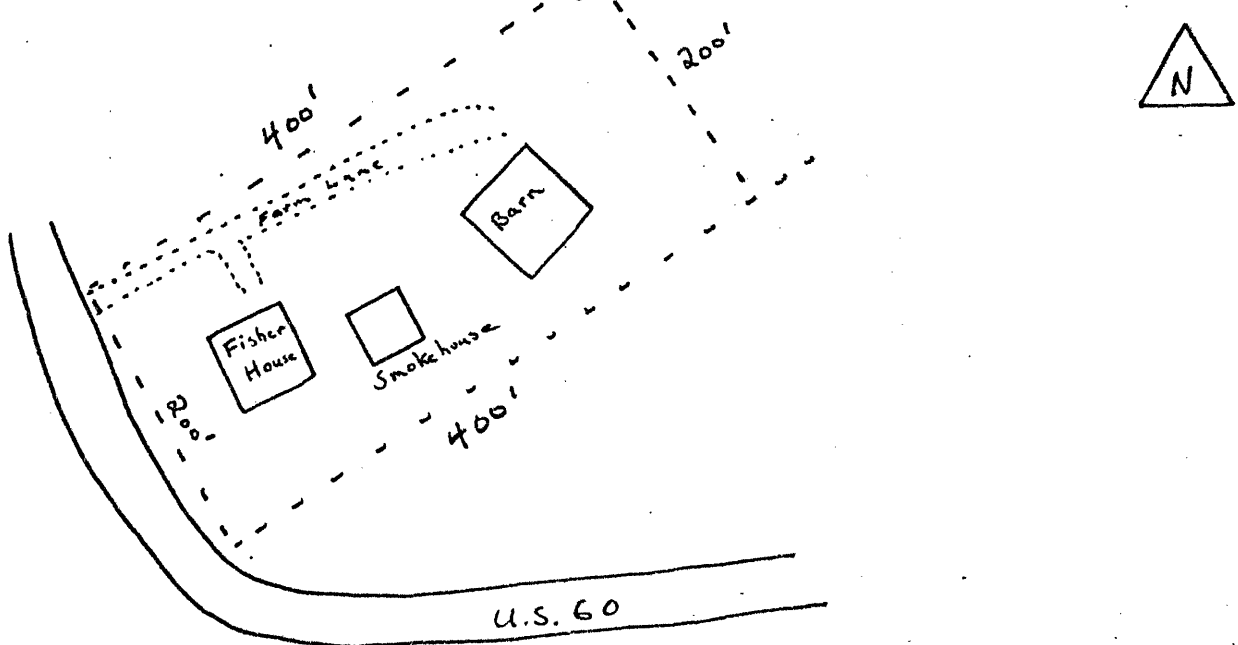
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
