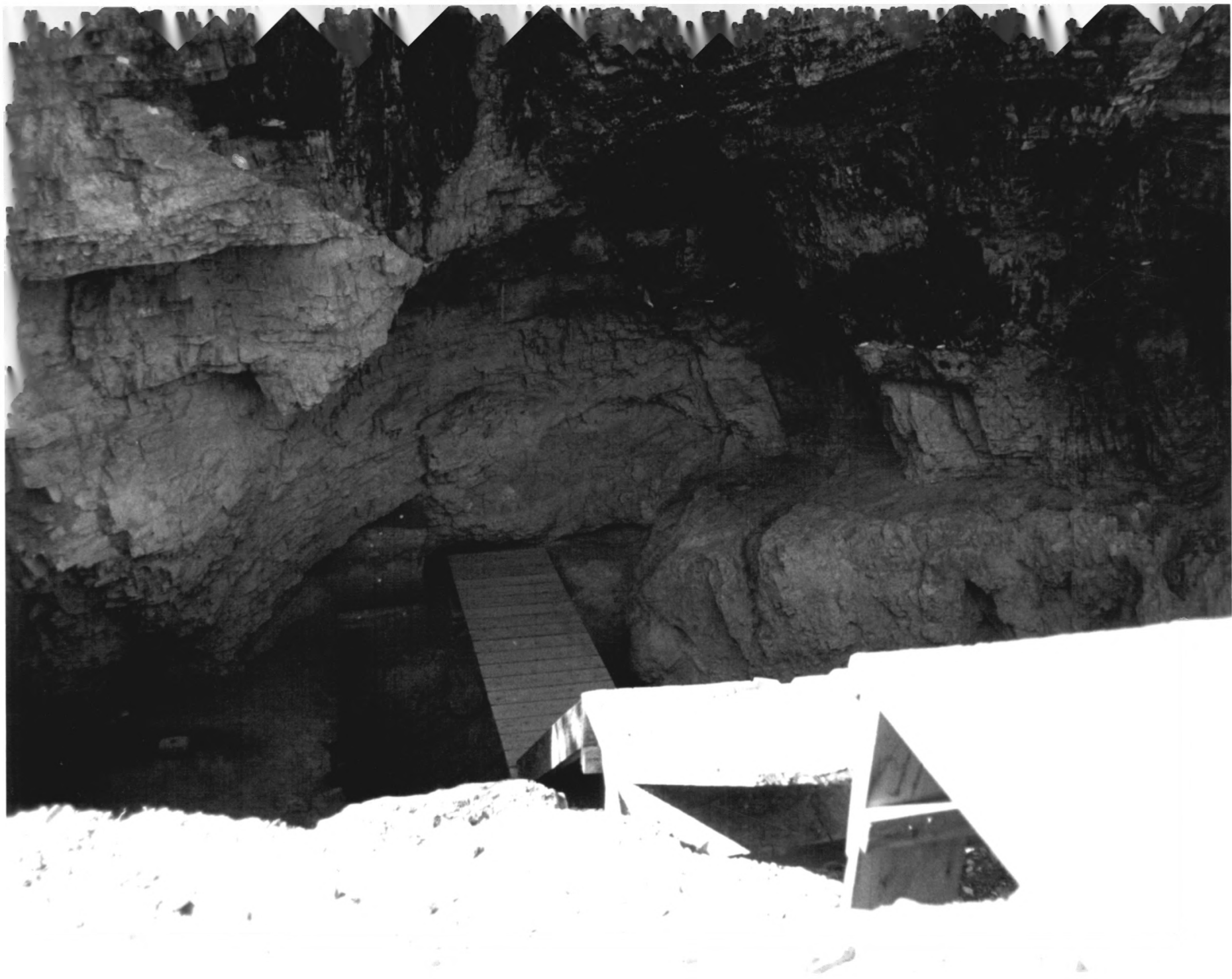

DESCRIPTION: A view looking north across Mill Creek and the backdirt piles, into the shelter opening. The temporary ramada was used by field crews as a laboratory area. Note that loose rock rubble forms a talus slope above the site that has over the millenia accounted for a portion of the deposits within the shelter.

LOCATION OF NEGATIVE: Division of Historic Preservation and Archeology, Carson City, Nevada

DESCRIPTION: A view looking north-northeast down into the excavated portion of the Gatecliff Rockshelter. The white dashed line that appears intermittently across the shelter's back wall marks the original ground surface when excavation began at the site in 1970. The pictographs shown in PHOTO 1 are located on the shelter ceiling in the upper right hand corner of this photo. The excavated portion of the site extends some 4 meters below the level of the lower walkway. Note the permanent datum (concrete column with metal plate) in the lower left hand corner of the photo.

DESCRIPTION: This photo shows the clear stratigraphy present at the Gatecliff Rockshelter. Sorting is apparent in many of the depositional units. These deposits are at the back of the shelter and are, on the whole, finer than those found at or beyond the drip line.
