## DESCRIPTION

The Markey House, a T-shaped log house, faces south on a heavily wooded site. No external modifications have been made to the walls constructed of hewn logs. Half dovetail corner notching connects the logs which are presently chinked with portland cement mortar. Because the log house was moved from Pea Ridge Battlefield in 1960, it now stands on new foundation piers made of concrete block and fieldstone. All windows, double-hung four-over-four wood sash, are relatively modern.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Criterion: C Area of significance: Architecture

The Markey Log House is notable for having survived since construction date, c. 1880, with no major changes in its exterior materials on its floor plan. Originally built c. 1880 within the Pea Ridge Battlefield National Park almost twenty-two years after the battle, it was made available to the public when the National Park was formed. A purchaser moved the house to its present location. Few 19th century log structures in Benton County are so well-preserved or so little changed, and the building is the only log structure included in the MRA for that reason.

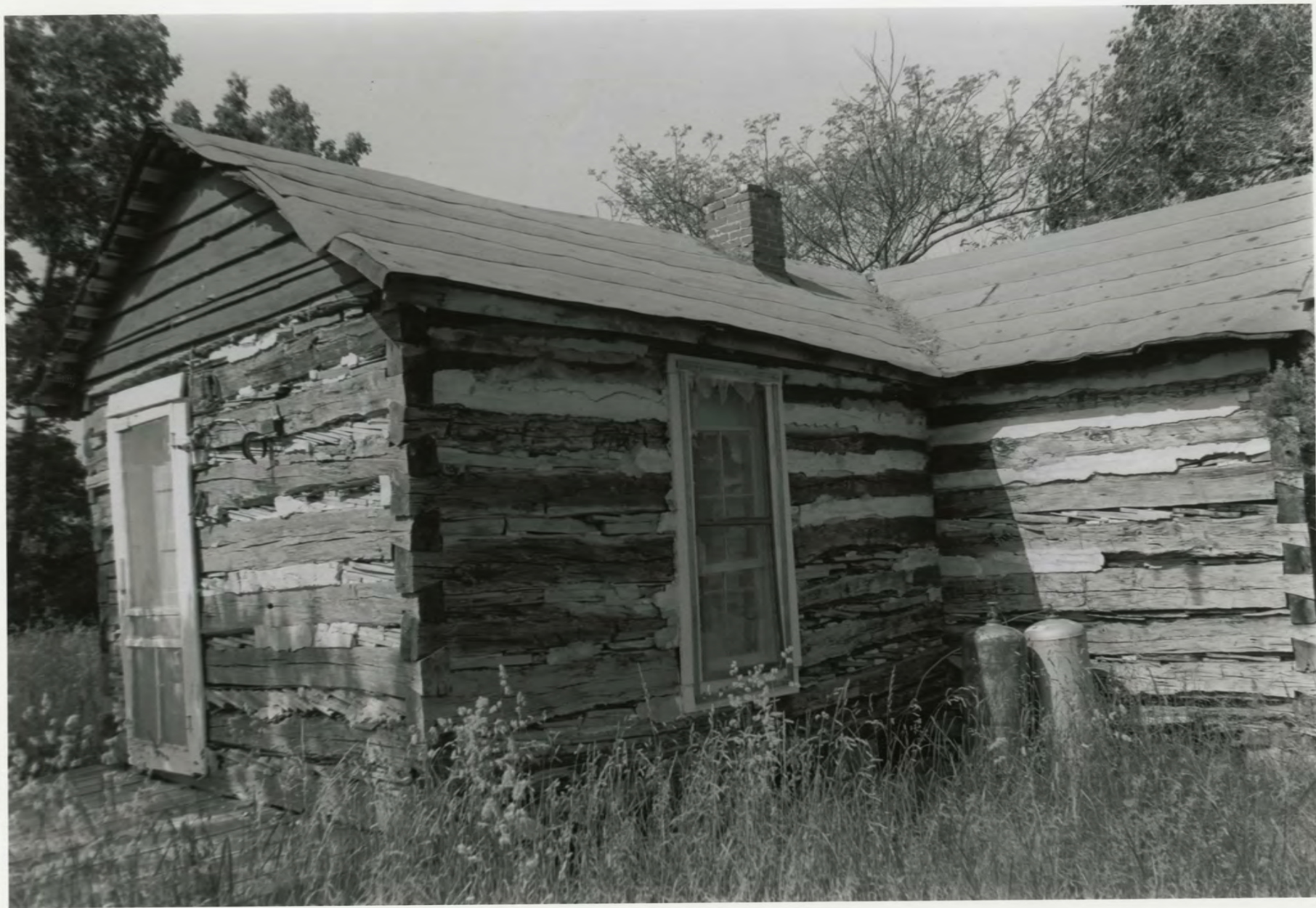
