

PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: <p><i>This three-inch vertical plank house is one-and-a-half stories with gable roof and rests on a granite foundation. The main block measures roughly 32'x20' and is five bays across by two deep; an ell extends to the west. Windows are 6/6 double hung sash with plain surrounds. The central entry is the building's most notable feature and consists of a six-panel door framed by fluted surrounds with corner blocks and topped by a centered rectangular panel with raised diamond motif. This treatment is flanked by four-pane sidelights resting on panels framed by fluted pilasters. The ell and connected garage measure 42'x15' and are set back seven feet from the main house, an area which provides for an open porch supported by bracketed posts. The four-pane transom light over the garage door suggests that it was once used as a barn.</i></p> <p><i>(See continuation sheet)</i></p>	
STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: <p><i>The Garber property (c. 1835) is a farm property which continues in agricultural use. In addition to its architectural significance as a plank house, its finely detailed frontispiece is also noteworthy. This is one of two plank houses with this type of door treatment (the other is the Burford House, Site #7). The stepped lintel arrangement above the door is reminiscent of high style Federal door surrounds.</i></p>

Verbal Boundary Description and Justification:

*Boundaries of the nominated property are highlighted in yellow on the attached sketch map. These boundaries represent the surviving acreage still associated with the house.*

Description (continued):

*Southeast of the ell is a gable-roofed barn with board and batten siding; it has two additions, one with a gable roof and one with a shed roof. There are also two shed-roofed henhouses and a gable-roofed shed, all of which are sided with vertical boards and roofed with roll roofing. The complex is grouped around a circular drive. There is fenced pasture, cleared fields, stone walls, gardens, and livestock present, all of which reinforce the agricultural character of this farm property. The balance of the land is tillage and woodland.*

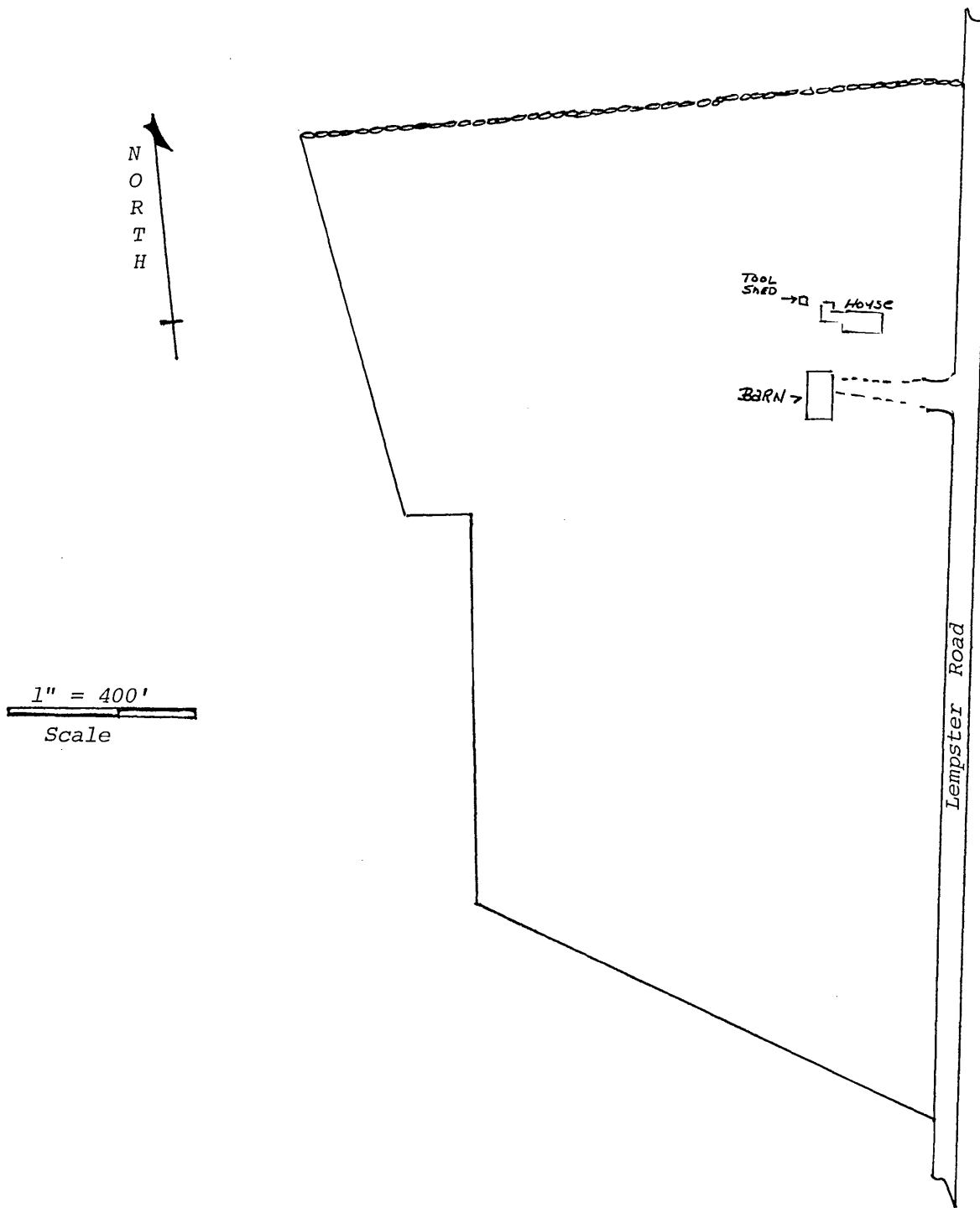
