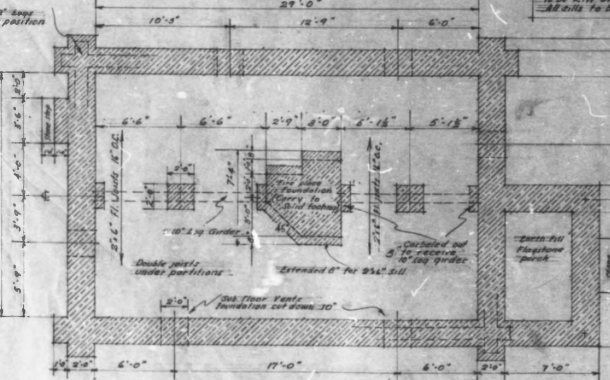


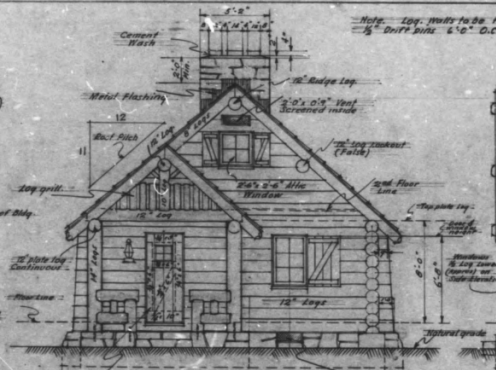
Notes:

Note: All wood members in contact with masonry to be 2" W or dressed. All bills to be E.W.

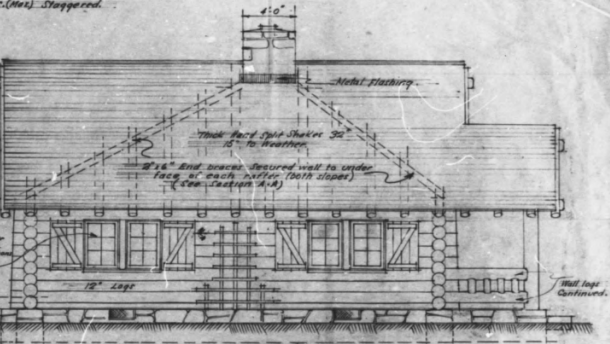
FLOOR PLAN
 Scale 1/4" = 1'-0"



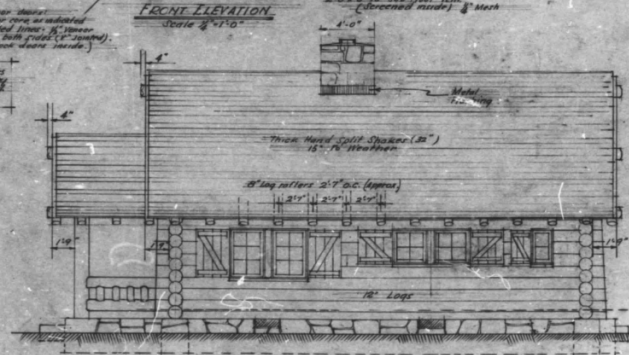
FOUNDATION PLAN (STONE)

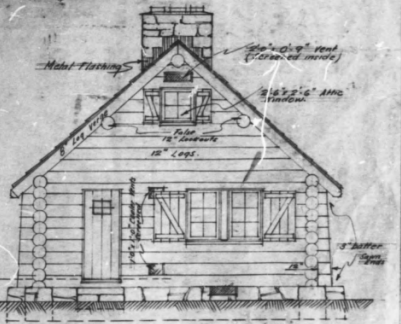
FRONT ELEVATION

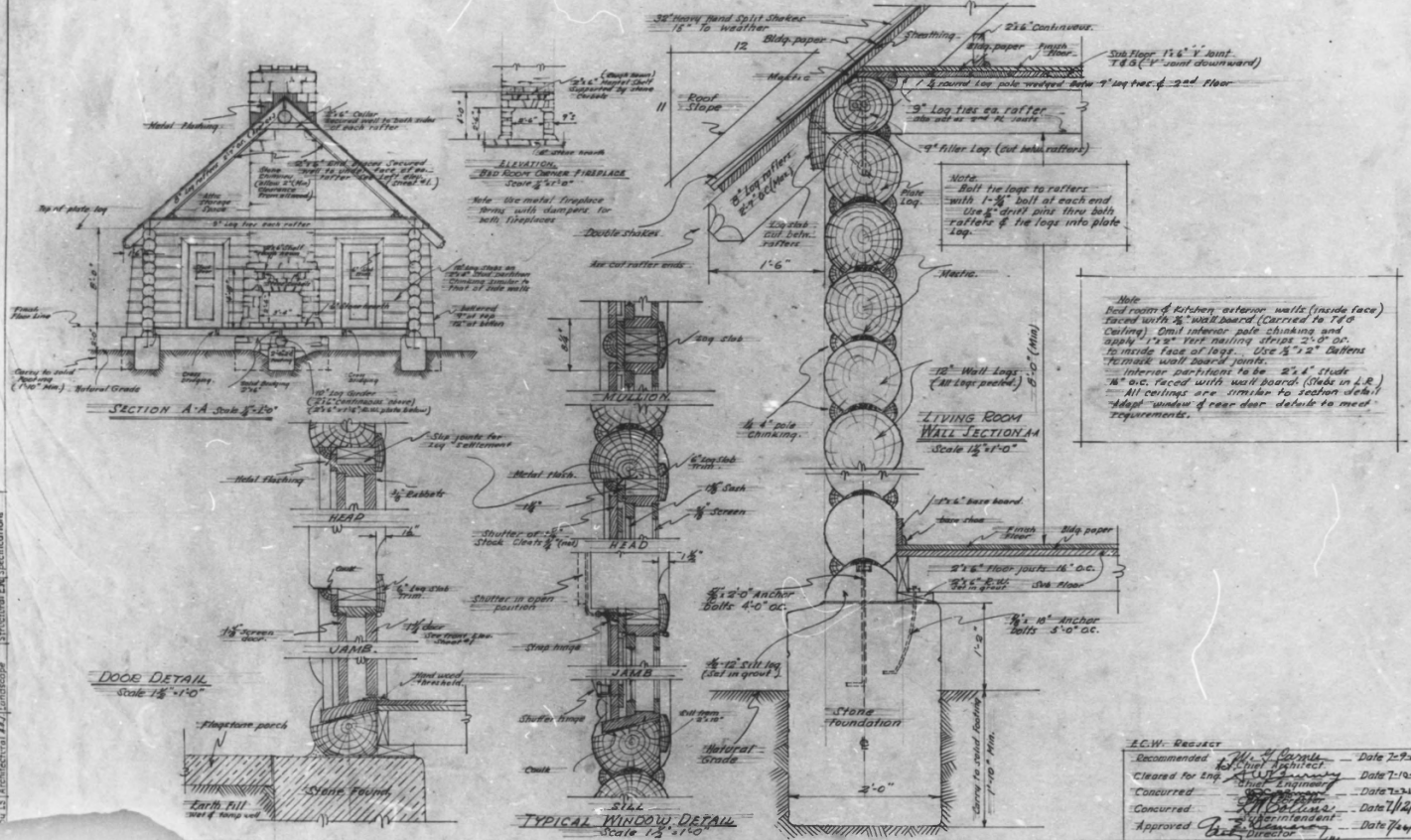

Note:
 Split the logs to rafters with 1/2" ball at each end. Use 3/8" drill pins thru both rafters & the logs into plate lag.

Note:
 End rooms of kitchen exterior walls (inside face) faced with 1/2" wall board (carried to T&O ceiling). Small interior plate chinking and supply 1/2" x 2" pine nailing strips 2'-0" o.c. to inside face of logs. Use 3/4" x 2" battens to make wall board joints.
 Interior partitions to be 2 1/2" thick 18" o.c. faced with wall board (made in I.R.)
 All ceilings are similar to section detail. Moldings of rear door details to meet requirements.

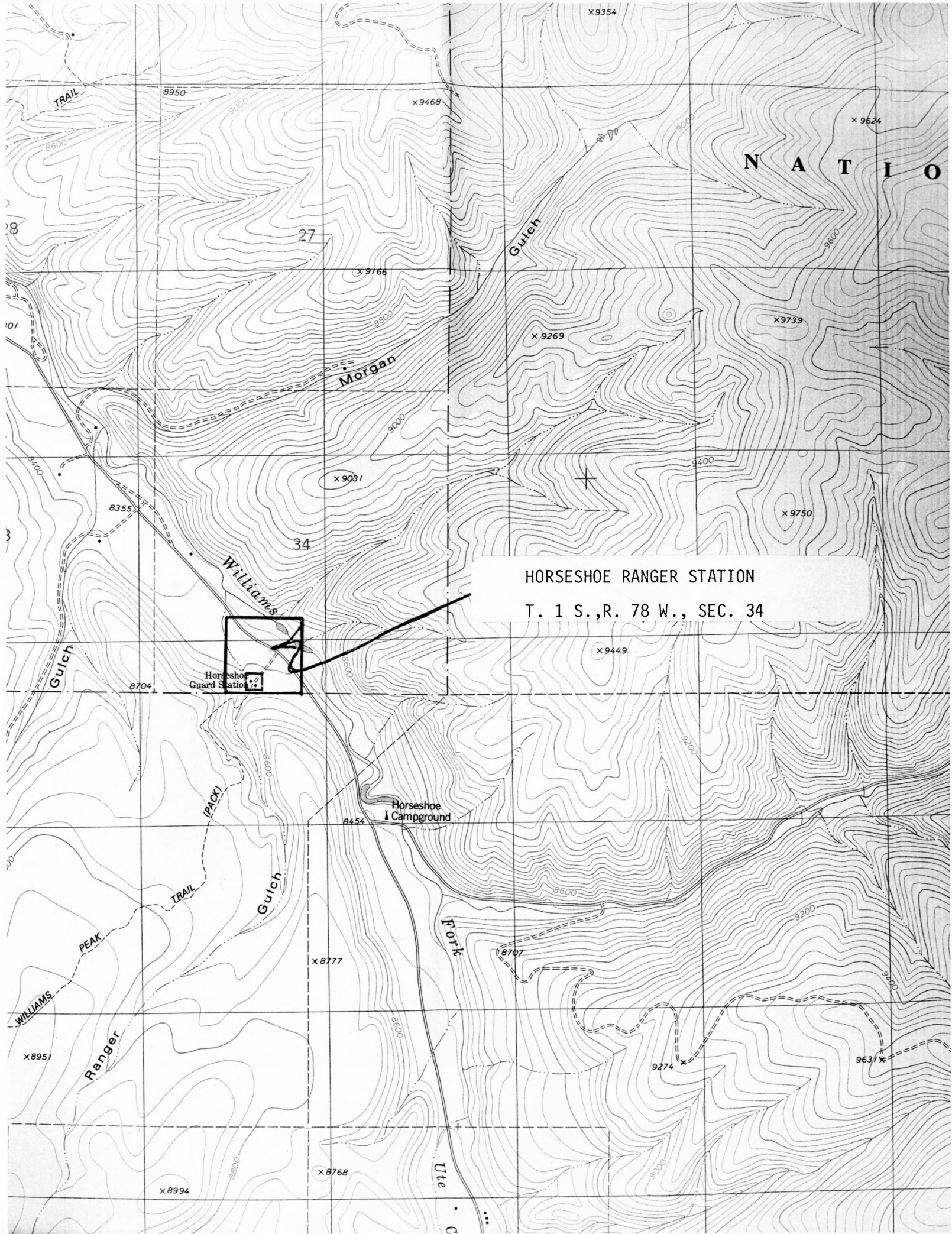
