

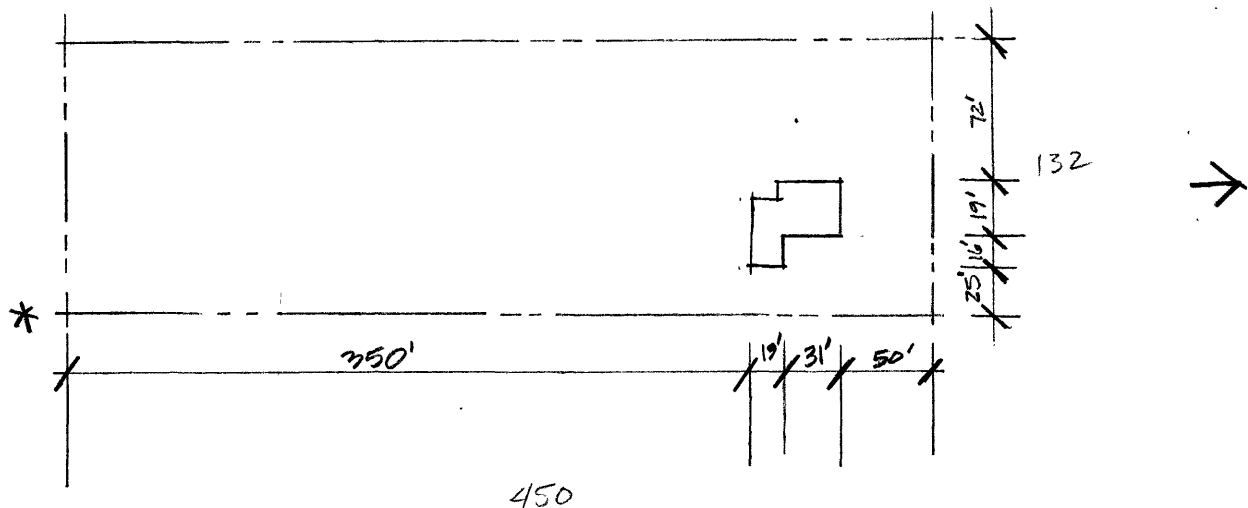

The point of beginning is 25 feet west and 350 feet south of the southwest corner of the Blakeman House.
