DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Old Yaquina Bay Lighthouse is situated on a bluff forming the north bank of the mouth of the Yaquina River. It is a two-story framestructure on a high brick basement lighted by small openings. Oriented to the west, it has a shingled gable roof with a medium pitch. A square light tower or platform for the lantern rises the height of one story at the central bay on the east elevation. The tower is contained within the plan of the house and does not project beyond the outside wall.

The main block measures approximately 34' by 24'6". A single-story ell, or workshop and storeroom extension originally measured 29' by 12'6". It was semi-enclosed, with a gallery or loggia running the length of the south side and set off by three posts with brackets. The storeroom was removed in the course of rehabilitation work dating from the 1960s.

Access to the building is gained through a door on the north side of the east elevation which is sheltered by the ell, and through a central door in the west face which is protected by a porch. The porch is reached by a flight of wooden steps. It has a gable roof which was originally supported by bracketed posts. Railings extended from posts to the outside wall, and the pediment of the roof was decorated with scroll work cut out by band saw.

Fenestration, consisting of double-hung sash windows with six lights over six, is formally arranged. On the west face there are two bays on either side of the entry on the first story level. At the second story level there is only one window on either side of that which lights the central hall. The east elevation is divided into three bays. There are three windows at the ground story level of the north end wall, and two at the second level. The south end wall is lighted by a single window in each story. Each of the window surrounds is finished with a flat lintel in the shape of a pediment and small brackets under the corners of lug sills. Windows on the west face were originally protected by double-leaf storm shutters.

The horizontal weatherboards of redwood are of the shiplap type, or rebated. Corner boards are plain. The cornice was originally molded. Downspouts reached to the ground from wooden gutters. Two brick chimneys with corbelled bases and caps straddle the ridge of the roof. They are set in from the gable ends. The platform for the iron lantern is bracketed. The lantern is octagonal, as was the original platform railing.

Interior spaces are formally arranged around a central stair hall. There are five rooms downstairs, in addition to the hall, and four rooms upstairs. Wood window and door frames are elaborately molded. Original baseboards are finished with ogee molding. Fireplaces in the two front rooms downstairs and the NW room upstairs are surrounded by wooden chimney pieces. The chimneypiece in the SW room upstairs was covered by a wall which was added to form closets on either side. This alteration was carried out at a reasonably early date, apparently, and at the same time vertical tongue-ingroove wall cover was laid over original plaster walls downstairs as well as in the SW room upstairs. The straight flight of stairs to the upstairs hall has a shaped handrail and turned spindles and newel post. Stairs leading to the light tower from the east end of the upstairs hall consist of winders without quarter spaces.

Plumbing, wiring, and alterations to the rear rooms of the first story date from 1934 to 1940 when the building was occupied by park personnel.

The Old Yaquina Bay Lighthouse is, after the Cape Blanco Light constructed in 1870, the oldest extant lighthouse on the Oregon Coast. It was the only lighthouse and domicile combined in a single structure erected in the State, although the type was somewhat typical elsewhere on the nation's coastline in the decade of the 1860s. However, most of the single-structure facilities were of brick masonry construction, whereas the Yaquina Bay light is a frame building. The oldest building in the bustling resort town and seaport which dates its commercial development from 1866, the lighthouse symbolizes historic Newport in the estimation of local residents.

The original Yaquina Bay Lighthouse was constructed between May 1 and October, 1871, as a harbor entrance light. It was illuminated in November of the same year. The lighting apparatus consisted of a whale oil lamp, most likely, and a Fresnel lens of the 5th order.

Construction records in the National Archives show that there were two principal contracts. The first was for fitting together the lantern and iron work to Joseph Bien, Lampist, San Francisco, California, dated June 16, 1871. The second was for furnishing all labor and work necessary for completion to Ben Simpson, a local contractor, dated June 19, 1971, - - -

The Lighthouse Reservation consisted of 36 acres, a part of the homestead of Lester P. and Sophronia S. Baldwin, who were among the first white settlers on Yaquina Bay. The warranty deed certified by Benton County Clerk W. B. Wilson, was dated April 28, 1871. The Baldwins sold the land to the U. S. Government for a consideration of "\$500 U.S. Gold Coin."

Within the short span of three years, the harbor light station was superseded. In August 1873 a lighthouse three miles to the north at Yaquina Head was completed. The old light was extinguished October 1, 1874. It was never reactivated, although the federal government maintained the lighthouse and reservation and performed minimal repairs through 1885.

The only lighthouse keeper appointed to duty on the reservation was Charles H. Pierce, a Scot and former Civil War Captain for the Union Army who cared for a wife and eight children in the house. Upon closure of the light, "Captain" Pierce was assigned to duty on Oregon's Cape Blanco Light Reservation.

It is reported that Royal A. Bensell and his wife succeeded to occupancy of the building for a time as caretakers. Bensell is notable in local history for having kept a journal of Army life at Fort Yamhill on the Coast Indian Reservation and for having been one of the earliest promoters of Yaquina Bay when the country was officially opened for settlement in 1866. Bensell made his mark as publicist for the entrance to the Yaquina (Cont'

8. Significance - (Correction)

The first paragraph of the statement of significance should read as follows. Corrected information is given in italics.

The Old Yaquina Bay Lighthouse is, after the Cape Blanco Light constructed in 1870, the oldest extant lighthouse on the Oregon Coast. It is the only one of two examples of the type of lighthouse combined with domicile in a single structure erected in the state which survives today. The Point Adams Lighthouse, erected at the Mouth of the Columbia River in 1858, was a more elaborate example of the type. It burned in 1912. The single structure type was somewhat typical elsewhere along the nation's coastline in the decade of the 1860s. Many were of stuccoed brick masonry construction. The Point Adams Lighthouse was a frame construction, as is the Old Yaquina Bay Lighthouse. The oldest building in the bustling resort town and seaport which dates its commercial development from 1866, the Old Yaquina Bay Lighthouse symbolizes historic Newport in the estimation of local residents.
