St. Mark's Episcopal Chapel is significant architecturally as a well preserved board-and-batten Gothic Revival parish Church. The chapel was constructed in 1871 under the guidance of Octavius Longworth and Dr. David B. Knickerbacker. Both men had been members of St. Mark's Church in Brooklyn, New York. Mr. Longworth came to Minnesota in 1859 and settled on Clearwater Lake in Corinna township. The Rev. Knickerbacker became rector of Gethsemane Church in Minnea- polis; he occassionally visited Longworth's homestead to give services The two men decided to build a Church in rural Wright County.
