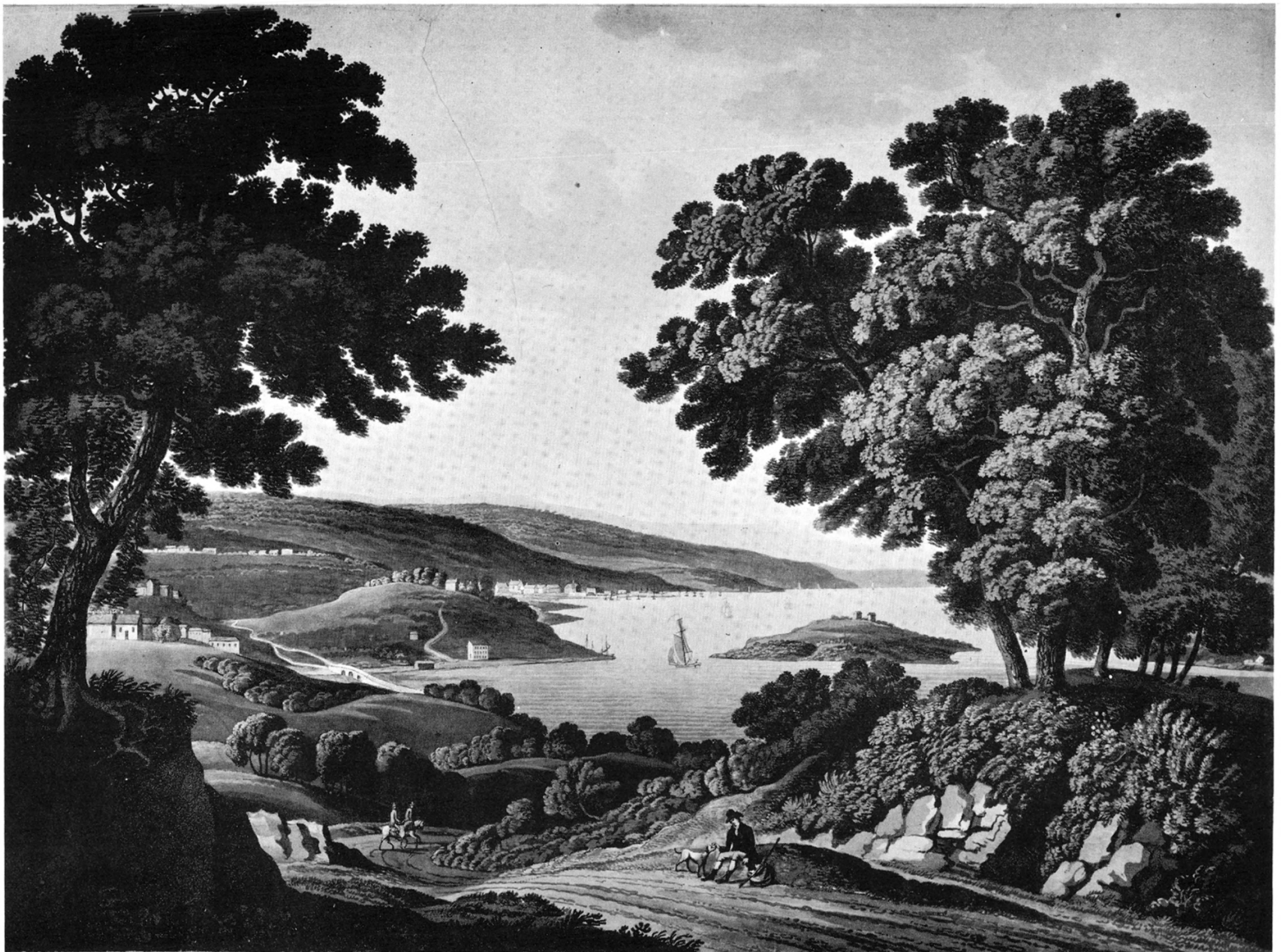

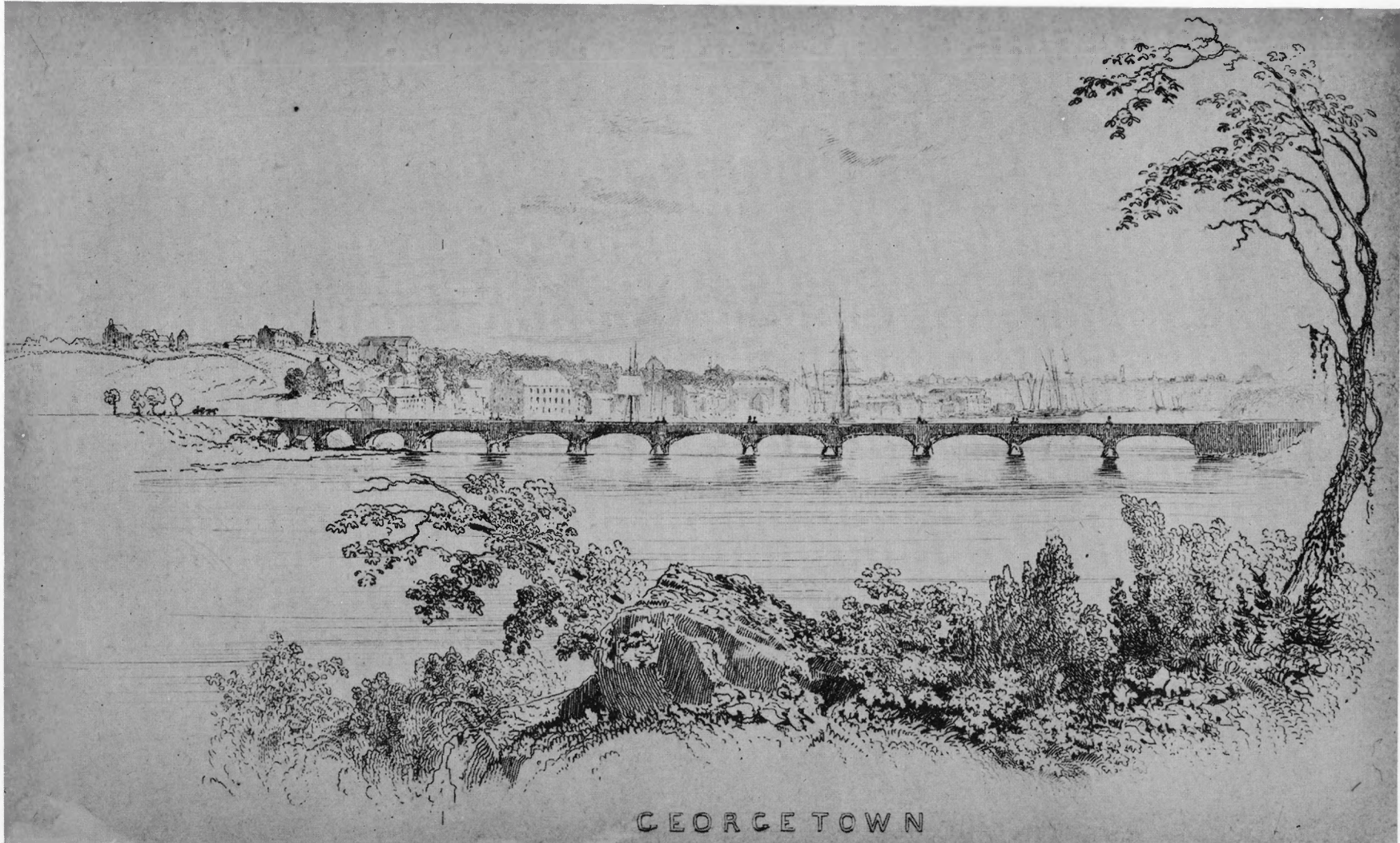

Early View of Washington from the George Town Heights



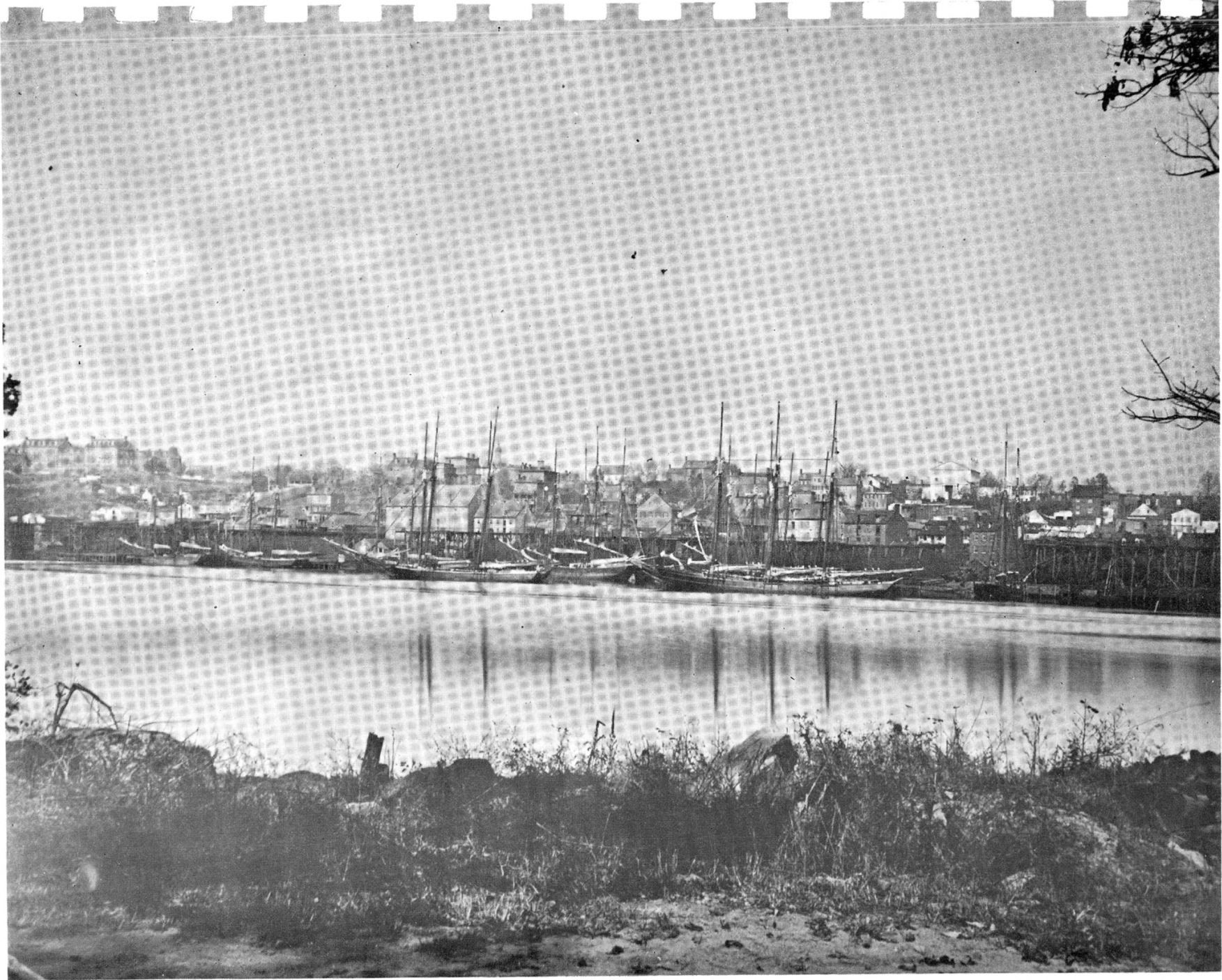

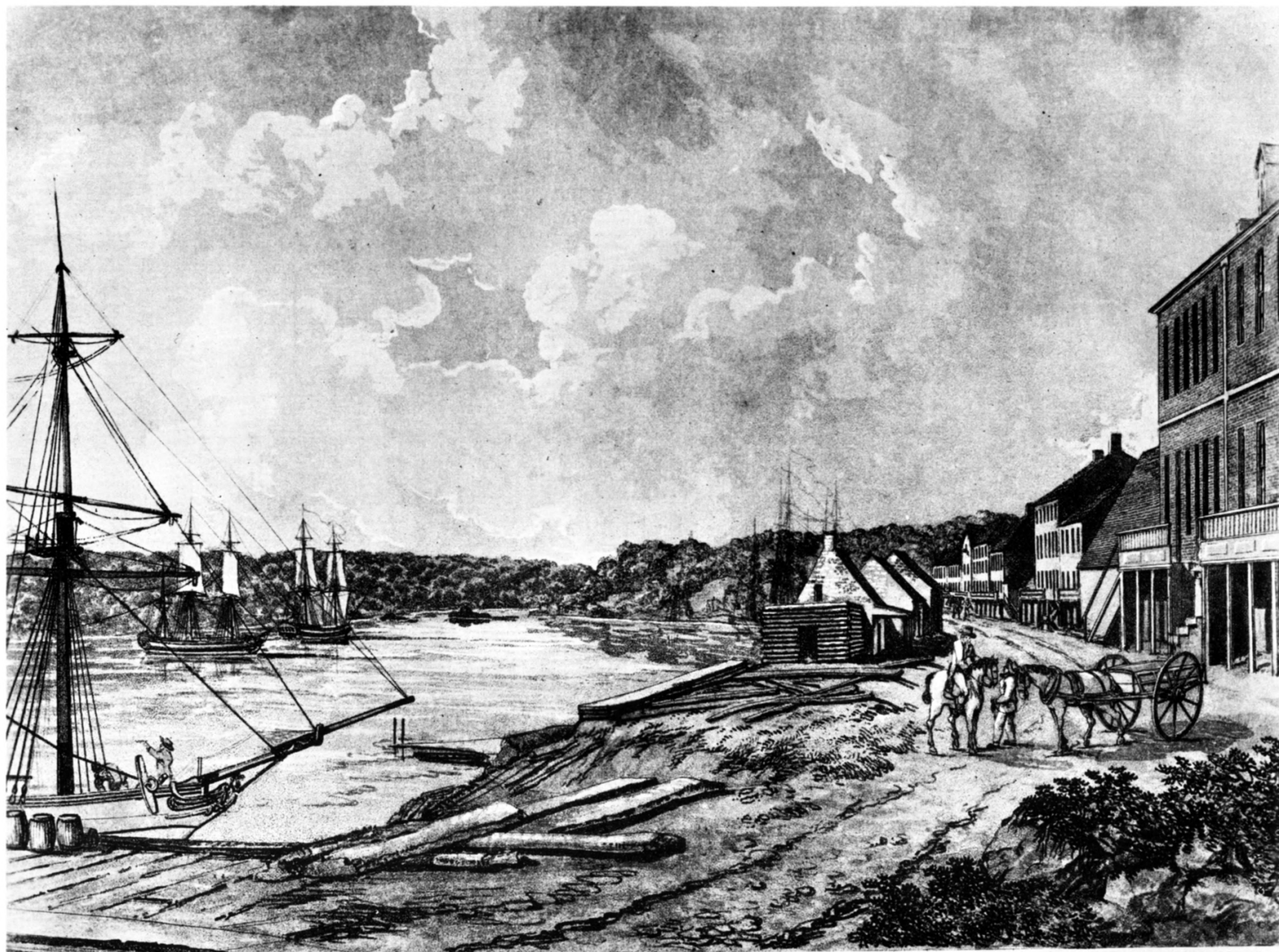
George Town Waterfront and Aqueduct Bridge



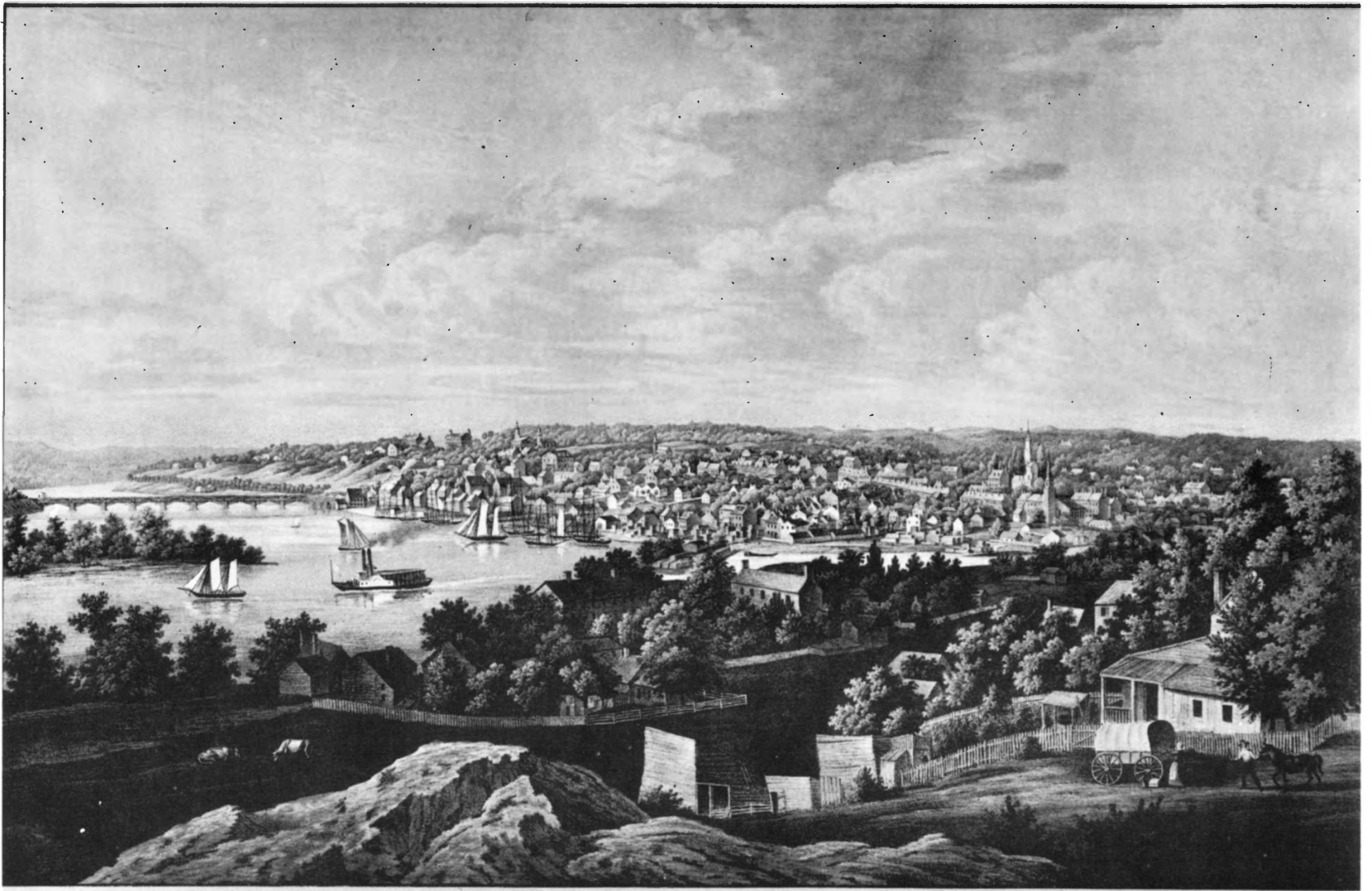

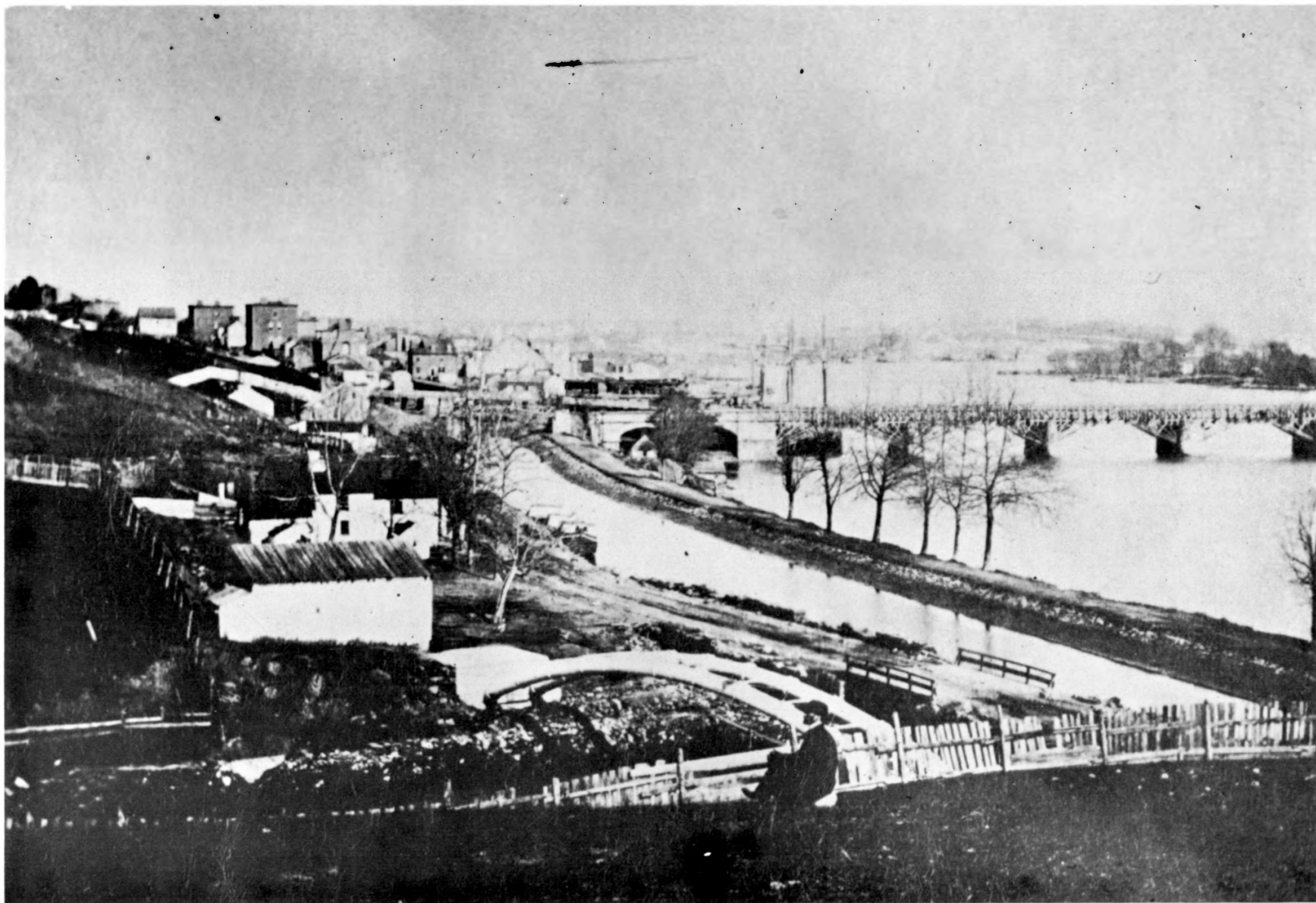

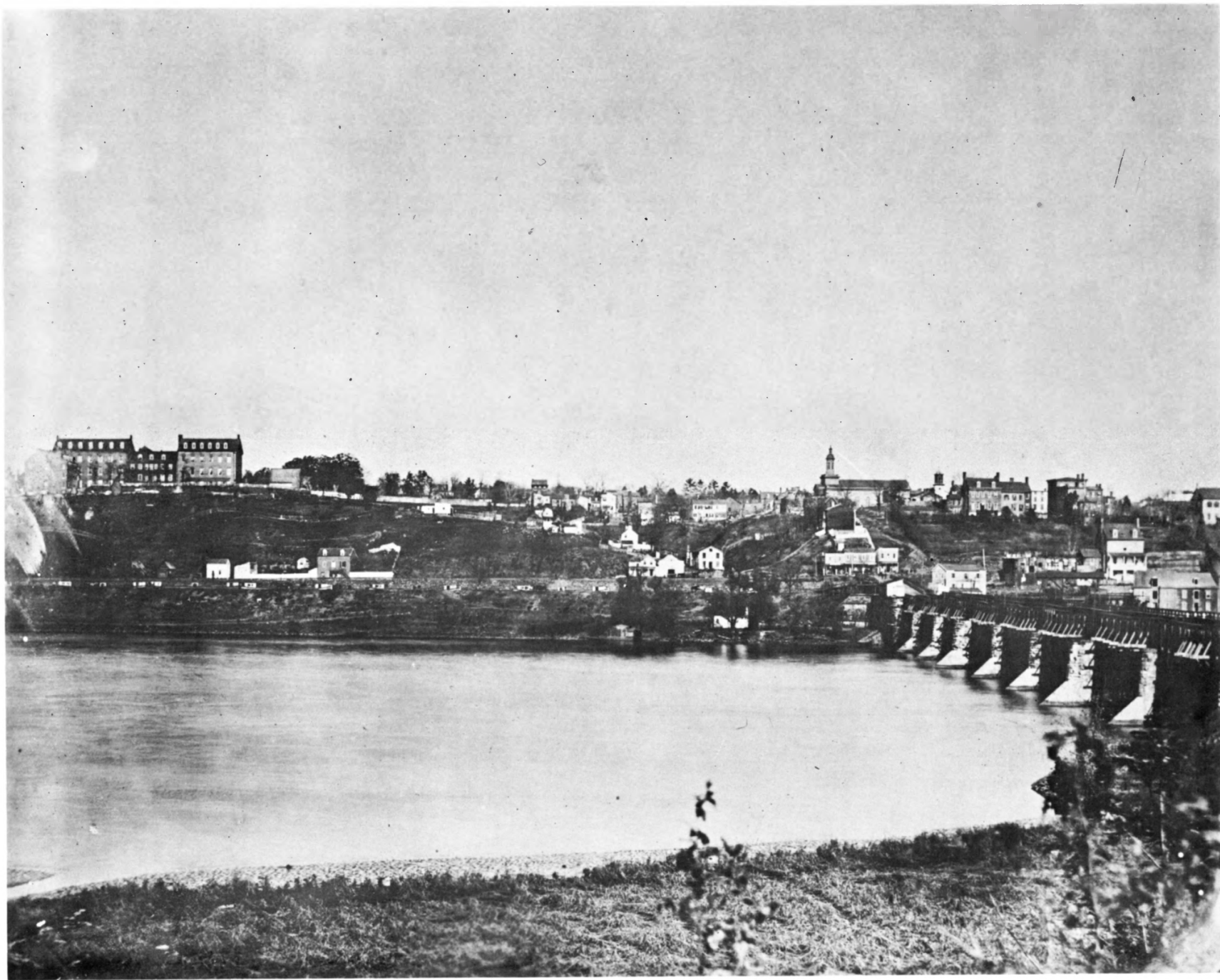

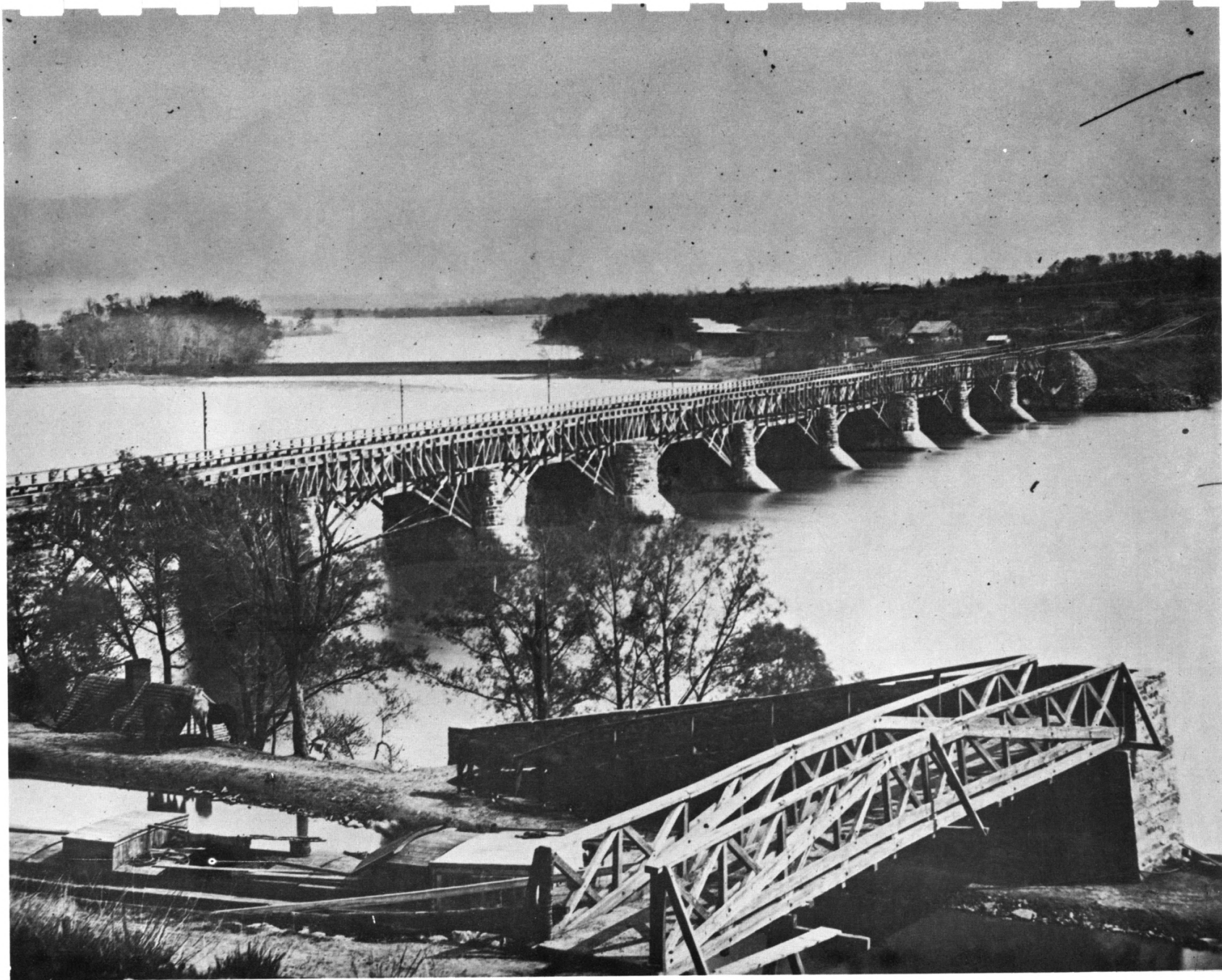
