Description

The Bethlehem Baptist Church was constructed in ca.1920. Its architect is unknown. The building is constructed in the Colonial Revival architectural style with Greek Revival style influences and represents the American Traditional property type. It retains integrity of design, workmanship, and feeling. The Bethlehem Baptist Church has been in continuous use as a church from ca.1920 to the present day.

The Bethlehem Baptist Church is located on the northeast corner of 14th and Adams Streets and faces south onto Adams Street. The site is characterized by grass and concrete surfaces and mature trees. No outbuildings are located on the site.

The Bethlehem Baptist Church is a rectangular, one-story building of brick construction. The building is divided into vertical bays by brick pilasters located along the sanctuary walls. It measures 45 x 25 feet. The gable roof is covered with asphalt shingles. It has a concrete foundation. The walls are sheathed with stucco with clapboard at the gable.

Exterior features include the dominant temple front with recessed portico. Four stylized Doric concrete columns support the pedimented gable roof. Other characteristic details include boxed comices, eave returns at the rear gable wall, and half-round gable ventilator. A paired wood panel door with transom is centrally located beneath the portico. Openings for the sanctuary windows are segmental arched and infilled with stucco panels or stained glass windows.

Alterations are limited to the window infill panels.

Statement of Significance

The Bethlehem Baptist Church is significant under Criteria C in the area of Significance of Architecture. Built in ca.1920, the Bethlehem Baptist Church is a excellent local example of the Colonial Revival architectural style with Greek Revival influences and therefore represents the historic context "Religious Architecture in Phoenix, 1910-1942." The building is a good example of the American Traditional property type. The building possesses the important characteristics of the property type, specifically design ideas based on traditional American Colonial church architecture.

The Bethlehem Baptist Church is an excellent example of the revival of American Colonial architecture using characteristic Greek Revival temple front with recessed portico, gabled roof with boxed cornice, and half round ventilator. Strict attention to symmetry, another characteristic of its style, is also used in the Bethlehem Baptist Church. The combination of tradition form and stylistic details used in the design help convey its association with the American Traditional property type.
