Bridge No. 49-095-190 carries a local road over Rock Creek approximately 6 miles south and 6.5 miles west of Howard. The 27' single span concrete slab bridge rests on a concrete substructure with concrete wing walls. Reinforcing bar visible due to spalling is of the square spiral type. The railing is a concrete solid parapet for the entire bridge length. It has no concrete panel flared ends. There are no sidewalks on this bridge. The aesthetics of the bridge are very poor due to extreme spalling. The integrity of the bridge is excellent and all bridge components appear to be original. It is interesting that the bridge is built without a skew even though the skew of the creek is substantial.

Bridge no. 49-095-190 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for reinforced concrete highway bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion C as the concrete slab bridge with the greatest length surviving in South Dakota and as pre-1920 concrete bridge. Concrete bridges, such as this one, represent the earliest, pre-standardization, experimental era in reinforce-concrete bridge construction, and are relatively rare. This bridge retains excellent integrity.

On December 5, 1916 the Miner County Commissioners decided to build a bridge at this location. In January, the Commissioners awarded contracts to the Pioneer Bridge Company and Lidbloom & Gustavson for 28 bridges. There is no clear indication of which company built Bridge No. 49-095-190.

Sixteen surviving concrete slab bridges were surveyed in the state. Bridge No. 49-095-190, built in 1917, has the longest span among these bridges, with a single span of 27 feet. This bridge represents a design at the outer recommended limits for its span type. Before 1920, a slab span 20 feet and over represented extraordinary engineering efforts to push this particular span sub-type to its limits to solve an unusual site problem.
