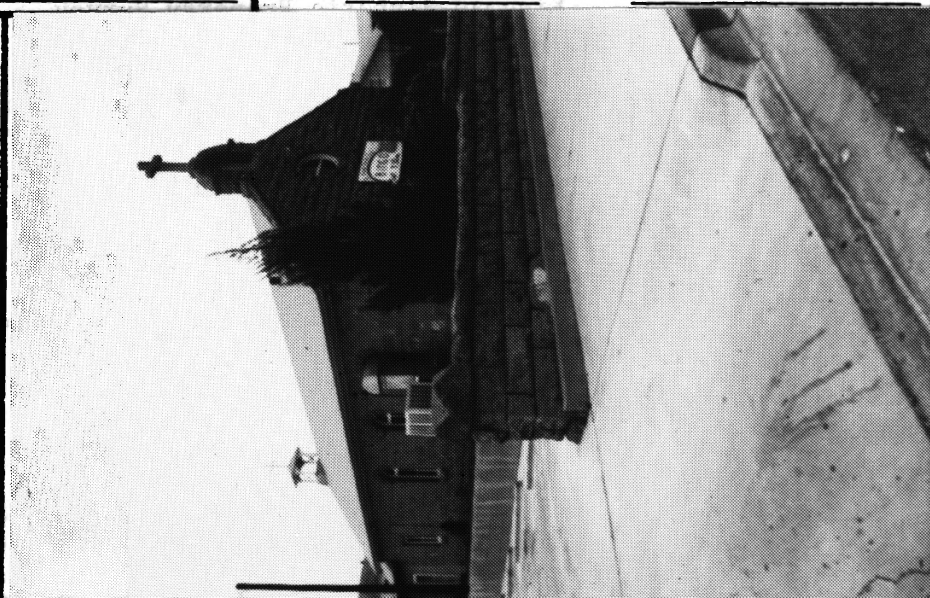

Served as home for Catholic congregation 1906-1967. Was second church built in Kingman and is now oldest remaining church building. Congregation financed building with fund-raising between 1903 and 1906. Stone from Metcalfe Quarry near Kingman.
