

ENGINEERING/STRUCTURAL DISTRICT/STREETSCAPE CONTRIBUTION DISCUSSION AS REQUIRED: Prominent Occupant/Historic Association(s) cont. on the school board, and as a pastor for St. John's Methodist Church, which he organized during the early 1880s. This is one of the oldest remaining houses and one of the few remaining adobe buildings in the city.
