Bridge No. 18-060-202 carries a local road across Twelve Mile Creek approximately 9 miles west and 10.2 miles south of Mitchell. The single span structure is a riveted and bolted Warren (with verticals) pony truss which rests on concrete back walls with concrete wing walls. The upper chord consists of two steel channel sections riveted with a continuous steel cover plate along the upper flanges and with riveted batten plates along their lower flanges. The lower chord consists of two steel channel sections riveted along the upper and lower flanges with batten plates. There are two configurations of verticals. Beginning with the end verticals, every other vertical is comprised of two angle sections riveted together with batten plates. The remaining three verticals each consist of a single angle section. The diagonals consist of two angle sections riveted together with batten plates. The two ply plank deck rests on Ibeam stringers, some of which have timber bolted to their webs. The stringers, in turn, are bolted to the I-beam floorbeams which, in turn, are bolted to the superstructure. The bottom laterals consist of threaded round steel rod. The railing is missing. The bridge appears to be original except for the missing railing; many of the verticals are bent.

The bridge retains good integrity.

Bridge no. 18-060-202 is being nominated to the National Register of Historic Places as part of the "Historic Bridges in South Dakota" Multiple Property Nomination. It is related to the historic context of "Historic Bridges in South Dakota, 1893-1943" and is classified with the associated property type for iron and steel frame bridges. This bridge is individually eligible for the National Register under Criterion C for its association with a South Dakota bridge builder, the Pioneer Bridge Company, and as the oldest surviving bridge in South Dakota built by that company. The bridge retains good integrity.

Although out-of-state firms captured the largest share of early 20th century bridge construction projects in South Dakota, there is one notable exception. Fred Bjodstrup of Mitchell maintained a competitive posture relative to out-of-state firms for nearly two decades, eventually being succeeded in 1912 by the Pioneer Bridge Company, managed by his son, Arthur Bjodstrup. Born in Denmark in 1857, Bjodstrup emigrated to the United States in 1876 and moved to South Dakota in 1882. Two years later he moved to Mitchell, where he established a construction business. As early as 1886, he was building bridges in Minnehaha County in partnership with F.P. George, an early Dakota bridge builder based in Parker, South Dakota. Bjodstrup was the principal bridge builder in Davison County from the early 1890s through 1911, and erected bridges in Miner and Aurora counties in the 1900s while bidding as well in Brown, Hamlin, Sanborn, and other counties. In addition to building bridges, Bjodstrup constructed commercial and other buildings in the Mitchell area. He ceased bidding on projects in 1912 after his son Arthur founded the Pioneer Bridge Company, which continued to receive annual contracts in Davison and Miner counties. Fred Bjodstrup continued working with his son until the early 1920s, when deafness forced him to retire. No bridges built by Bjodstrup prior to the formation of the Pioneer Bridge Company are known to survive.

Bridge No. 18-060-202 was constructed by the Pioneer Bridge Company in 1912. Six bridges built by the Pioneer Bridge Company were included in this survey. Among those, Bridge No. 18-060-202 is the oldest surviving bridge in the state built by this South Dakota bridge builder. Because of the small number of in-state bridge builders prior to 1920, bridges such as this one are important representations of attempts by South Dakotan's to compete with established out-of-state companies.
