## OLD SCOTS MEETING HOUSE

Old Scots Meeting House was built in the year 1692 by Scottish Presbyterians (Calvinists) on this ground known as "Free Hill". This site was the location of the first recorded Presbytery meeting and the site of the first ordination of a Presbyterian minister in North America in the year 1706. Now these Scottish exiles could worship freely in their own fashion. The granite border around the central monument marks the dimension of the small log structure that was the boundary of the Old Scots Meeting House. In 1731 the congregation moved to its present location in Tennent called Old Tennent Church.
