- Famous hexagonal Stagecoach Inn
- Built 1844 by Milton's founder Joseph Gardner
- 28 rooms Woodman Pioneer Exhibit
- 1837 Gardner Log Cabin
- Walk on the Underground Railroad
- Restored & operated by Milton Historical Society
- Listed on the National Register of Historic Places
