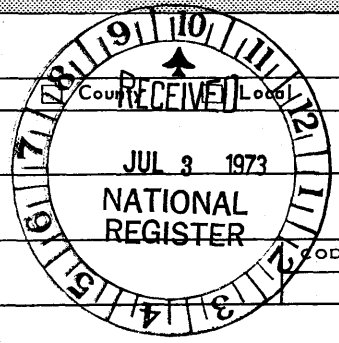

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Square in plan and two stories in height the Dial House is elegant in its exterior details and survives as one of the finest Victorian structures in the State. On the north facade of the house identical bays project on either side of the main entrance porch. All three are commonly roofed and share common corner brackets. This is a feature which is rarely seen among the Victorian residences in Florida. There are small entrance porches on the east and south sides of the house. Wide eaves project from the roof and are supported by paired brackets which are duplicated in miniature under the pent roofs of the first floor. Balustrades on all porches are identical. The house rests on brick piers with brick lattice between piers. A brick chimney sits at the rear of the roof and accomodates four interior fireplaces. A large cupola dominates the low hipped roof. Small sash windows occur in pairs on the cupola with the shutters permanently closed. Eave brackets are identical to those on the lower floors. The cupola roof is a low hip with needle spire and weather vane atop it.

Windows are two over two light double hung sash with exterior louvered shutters. All windows, with the exception of those located in the bays, have ornamental lintels identical in type to the one located over the main doorway transom.

The house has just been completely restored and landscaped and it is in an excellent condition.

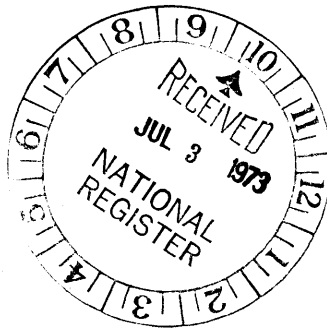

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

One of the finest of the late Victorian mansions in North Florida, this house was the town residence of Major William ~~H.~~ Dial, a Civil War veteran. He constructed it in approximately 1880 in the style typical of the late Victorian period. The house is representative of the affluence of the emerging Southern agriculturist during the post-Civil War period. Unique in its unchanged site and appearance, the house was owned by the same family for 91 years. Today after a complete restoration, the building still has its original hardware, shutters, window glass, doors and cornices.

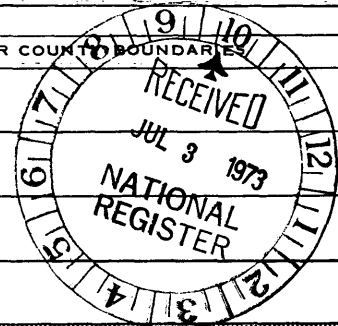
