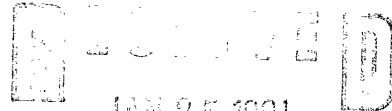

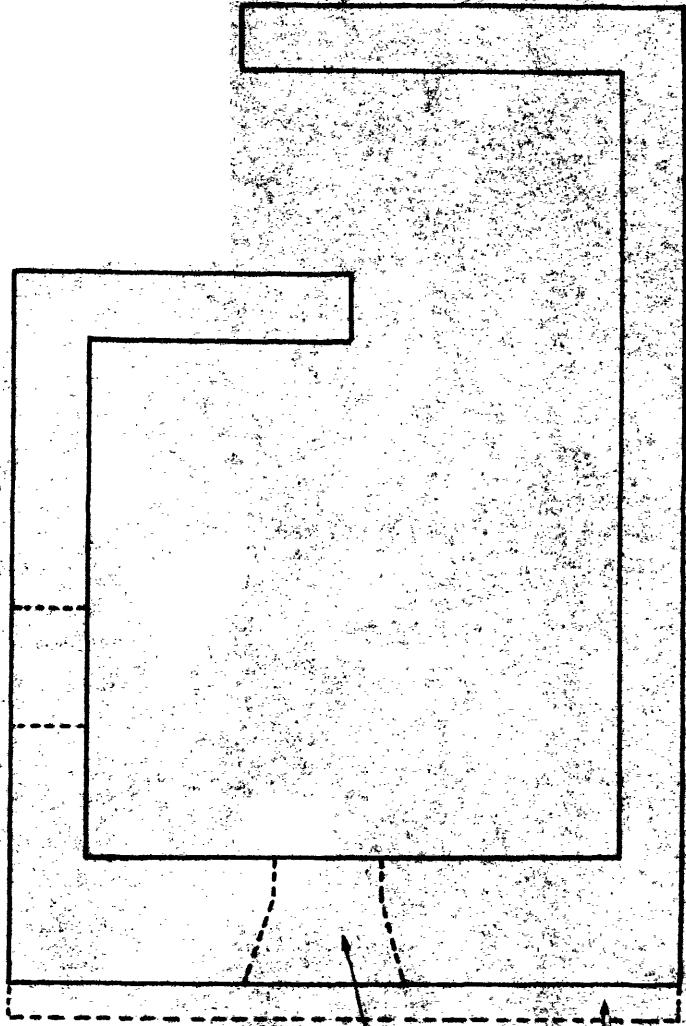
Talofofa Pillbox (66-09-1190)

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Talofofa Pillbox is located about 120.0m southeast of the Togcha River, 27.0m inland from the high tide line on a sandy berm about 2.0m above sea level. Built of reinforced concrete mixed coral rock, the structure is in excellent condition and appears to be in its original position.

The structure measures 2.75m by 3.0m. The highest point of the roof is 1.15m above ground surface. The roofline slopes to the north wall where an overhang or shield extends over the wall. A concrete projection measuring .12m by .28m, extends .25m above the roofline over the window on the east wall.

The north and east walls are .50m thick. The north wall has an embrasure with a view of the Togcha River mouth. The window of the east wall faces the beach and reef southeast of the river. The south and west walls are .30m thick. The window of the west wall faces inland. The entrance to the structure is located along the south wall which is the landward side of the pillbox. The space of the interior forms one room. The floor is sand.
