the first floor.On the second floor the bathroom is one step above the level of the hallway. The ridge dorme's are placed above the walk-in closets to give light and vemtilation. The upstairs partitions are 1 3/4" thick. Casement windows upstairs have unusual Flagg type hinges. The present owner added shutters to the house.

This house is architecturally significant because it is one of a group of stone masonry houses built by Arnold F. Meyer & Company, Inc. according to construction methods of Ernest Flags.— It is also gignificant because it is one of a row of three Flagg System houses designated as Milwaukee County Landmarks. There are five flagg System houses in the neighborhood.
