18. Description

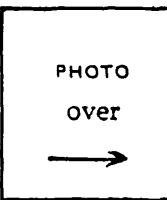
White frame, 2 1/2-story, gambrel-roofed Colonial Revival house ("Dutch Colonial" gambrel form), with enclosed verandah and balconied dormer above central bay window; 2/2 windows prevail. Attached and at right angles is a gambrel-roofed barn of similar size, style and proportions, connected by means of a short 1-1/2 story gabled ell with a double shed dormer. All are clapboarded, painted white, and gambrel ends have broad configuration. House and buildings are set on a rise of open land, bordered by stonewalls and row of trees along Old Troy Road, and tall pines at the back.

19. History

Built c.1914 by Mrs. William Amory as the "new" farmhouse and barn on her extensive estate, which comprised several earlier farms. Foothill Farm is markedly similar in style to the 1899 Amory (now Auchincloss, #148) house, and was very likely the work of the same architect, John Lavalle of Boston, Mass. (d. 1916). Bought as a residence by present owners in 193?. House is located about 225 feet from cellar hole sites of earlier house and barn.

20. Significance

Example of Colonial Revival gambrel-roofed ("Dutch Colonial") farmhouse complex associated with early 20th-century "gentleman's farms" of the Dublin summer colony.

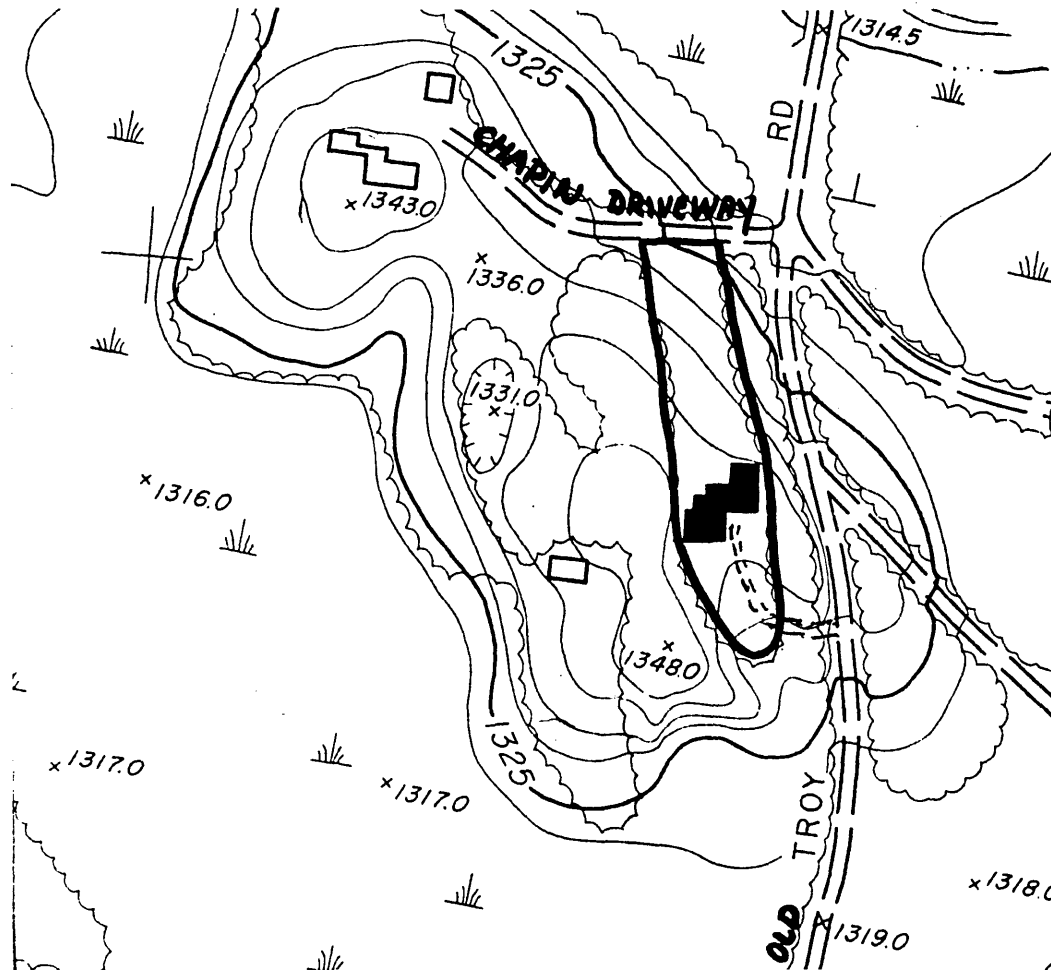

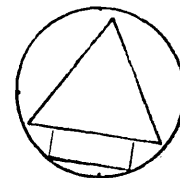
FRONT - SOUTH ELEVATION

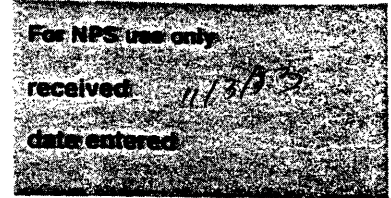
