## PRESENT

The Marshall House is a brick building in good interior preservation consisting of cellar, two stories, and attic. Two rooms and a hall are on each floor; stairs lead from first to second floor, and from second floor to attic. Inside dimensions of the house are about twenty-four feet wide by twenty-five feet deep.

The first floor is divided into front room fifteen and a half feet wide by thirteen feet deep; rear room fifteen and a half feet wide by twelve feet deep; and hall on the east side. The hallway has a front door facing south to Bridge Street, a stairway to the second floor, and rear, north door to outside. At this rear door there is a thick stone doorsill, suggesting that this door led outside before any of the rear additions were made. The hallway is eight feet wide by twenty-five feet long. The height of the rooms on the first floor is about eight and one half feet.

The second floor has a front room, last used by the nuns as a chapel and perhaps two rooms combined, twenty-four feet wide by thirteen and one half feet deep. The back room and hall with stairway to the attic take up the remaining dimensions. The floored attic has a plaster-walled room within a larger unfinished area.

æ Some details are noticeable in the interior. Fireplace openings are in \_ the two downstairs rooms. Six-paneled doors open to the outside and open into The interior doors are thin, one inch thick, and each room from the halls. appear to be hand planed. Cupboards with paneled doors are built beside the chimney in the four main rooms. A rounded chair-rail moulding is in the lower hall, the stairway walls, and the upstairs rooms. Windows of the house 0 number three in the downstairs front room, one in downstairs rear, four in z upstairs front room, and one in upstairs rear. These windows are large, fourpane replacements. Two small windows are in the attic. The house had an addition at the north rear end and another house adjoined on the east side. so no windows presently appear on the north and east sides.

### **ORIGINAL**

The original physical appearance of this brick dwelling is not known. To judge by descriptions of other house in early Lambertville, wood frame kitchens, wooden wash houses and tool sheds were common additions to brick main houses. The land the house stands upon was purchased by Philip Marshall in 1815. Presumably the house was built in 1816. The October 3, 1834 inventory of Philip Marshall's estate and contents of this house mentions kitchen, kitchen chamber, work shop, shop cellar, shop chamber, office, and shop garret, all apparently within a town lot measuring more or less thirty-three feet wide by two hundred deep.


### ARCHITECTURE

Mr. Martin Weil of the architectural firm of Price and Dickey stated that this dwelling, built in 1816, is of a design conservative for its time. The house has changed owners six times, and undergone various remodelings. Still, the basic house retains a feeling of proportion and dignity. Its thin-hand-worked doows, the chimney cupboards, the smooth-flowing balustrade, and the relatively large size of the hallways suggest the style of the eighteenth century. Philip Marshall, its first owner, was a wheelwright and wagormaker. His artisan's home is smaller in size than those of wealthier men, but no less rich in character.

#### U.S. HISTORY

The Marshall House is significant historically because it links New Jersey with the country's development beyond the Atlantic seaboard colonies, overland, to California and the Pacific. James W. Marshall lived in the house as boy and young man, then traveled from New Jersey to Misseuri Territory to northern California, serving in the Bear Flag War that hastened California's entry into the United States.

The Marshall House has added national importance as the home of the California gold discoverer. James W. Marshall left this house with the carpentry skills he had learned there, traveled over the breadth of the continent, and in association with Sutter built the sawmill and made the discovery of gold that abruptly altered the character of California and the whole nation.
