

Statement of significance:

This bridge consists of one Warren pony truss span, which was a commonly used truss type in early 20th century Mississippi. This particular bridge is significant in that it is representative of this type of truss, that is to say that it embodies "the distinctive characteristics of a type, period or method of construction." It was preserved by a 1983 agreement with the Claiborne County Board of Supervisors.
