DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Oddfellows Hall is a two-story cut stone building in the Renaissance Revival style. It is distinguished by its second story round arched windows with colored glass fanlights and a cornice broken by a pediment containing the eye and chain symbols of the order. Pilasters with simple caps demarcate the bays and a right of center round arched doorway leads to the second floor.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Oddfellows Hall is architecturally significant as a good example of the Renaissance Revival style rendered in stone. The structure is a landmark in Montpelier and one of the earliest lodgehalls in the state to employ stone as a building material.

This building is one of the few in downtown Montpelier to retain its integrity on both the first and second stories. The Odd Fellows still use the second story as their lodge hall.
