PHYSICAL DESCRIPTION: <p><i>The Janicke House is a one-and-a-half-story kneewall house with gable roof. Approximately two thirds of the building is of three-inch plank construction; there is a two-bay room of board and frame added later. The house is roughly 36' x 25' in dimension, five bays across by two deep, and is sheathed in clapboards. The 12/12 sash windows have plain surrounds as does the six-panel door. There are two chimneys, one off-center on the ridge, the other back of the ridge on the north slope. The windows in the gable end are 8/8 with plain surrounds. The lawn area around the house is bordered by trees. The balance of the property is tillage and woodland.</i></p>	
STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE: <p><i>This is a three-inch vertical plank house constructed c. 1830. It is one of three surviving plank structures within a one square mile area which formerly contained at least six. The others burned in a major fire forty years ago. John Chandler lived in this area and though this house pre-dates his period of building activity, it may have served as precedent to him. Chandler is known to have built the Center School (now the Cote House) which stands a few hundred yards from the Janicke House.</i></p>

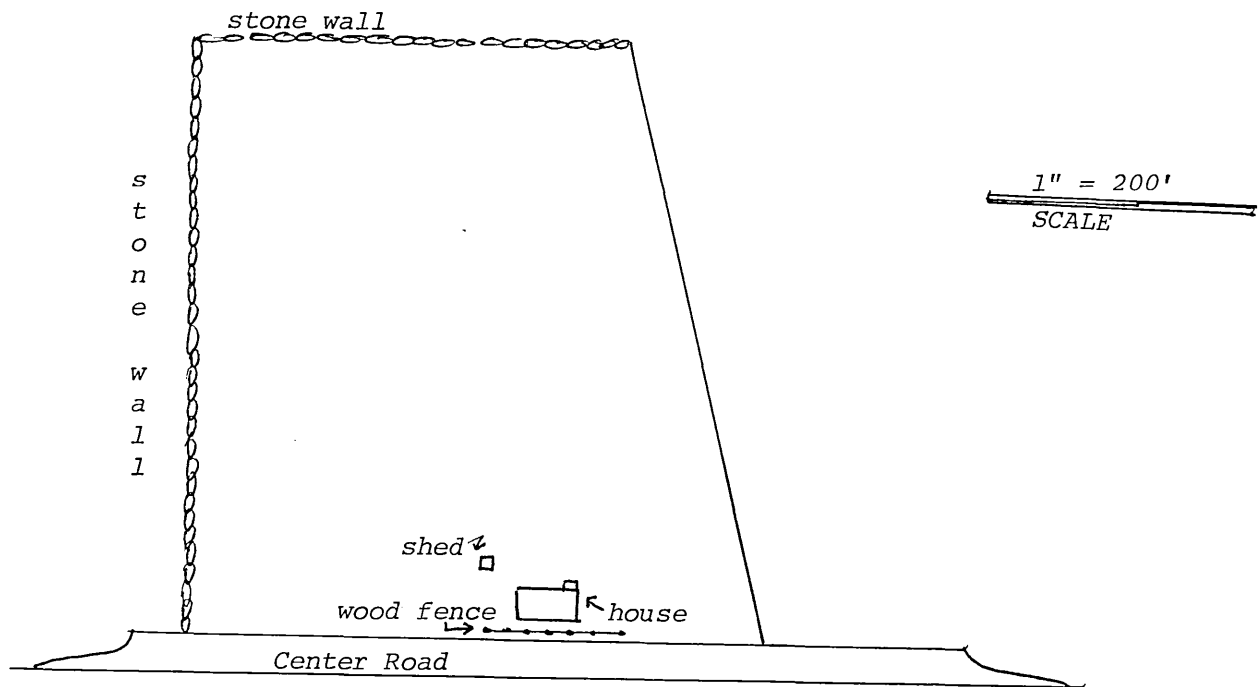
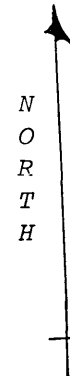
