III. Physical description of property and historical significance

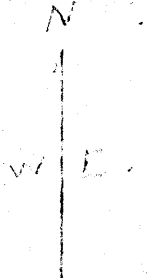
Located in a suburban setting, the Nelson House is an "L" shaped plan which incorporates two semi-octagonal bays and a large and prominent corner turret with a circumscribed Colonial Revival curving gallery. Many Louisiana Queen Anne residences have some reference to a turret, but few are as large, prominent, or well-developed as this. The house has movable louvered shutters, large plate glass windows, and an irregular side hall plan. A garage was added behind the house in the 1940's.

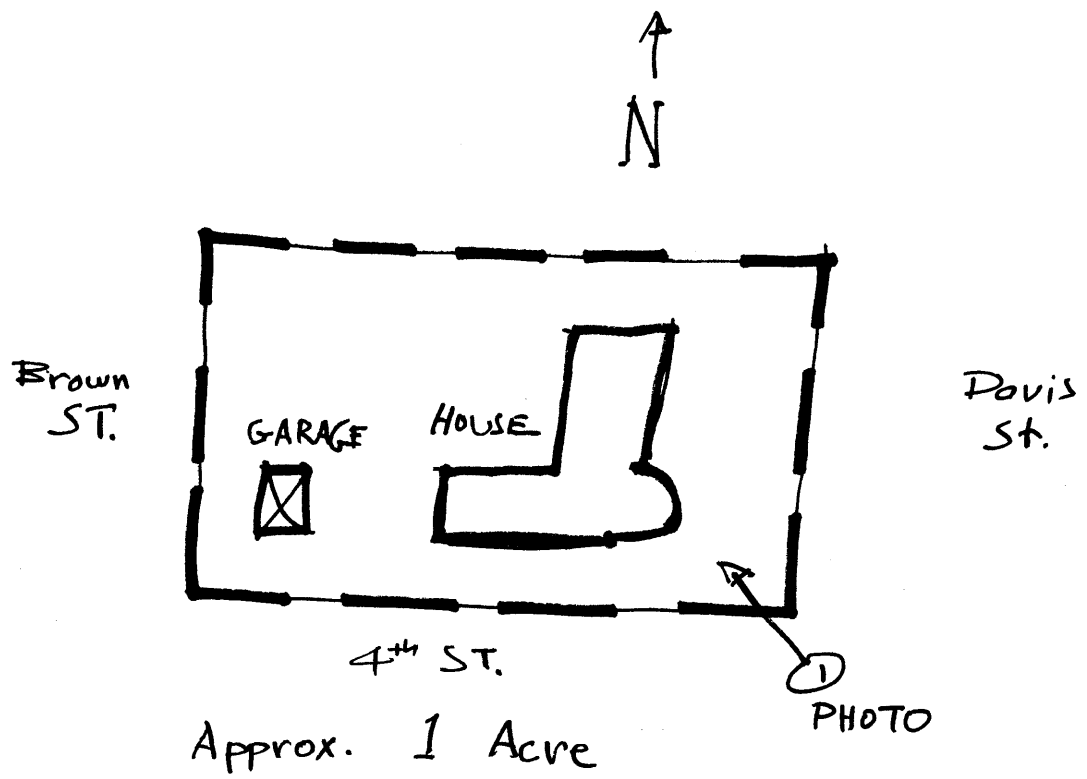
