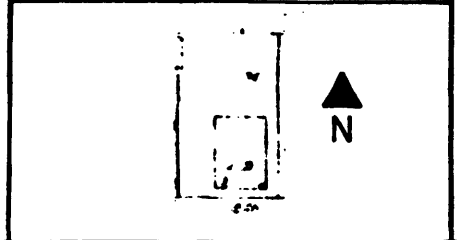

FORM 1½ story saltbox, 2 interior brick chimneys, 5-bay symmetrical front CONST. DATE c. 1865

MATERIALS Wood frame on stone foundation ARCH STYLE Vernacular

ALTERATIONS Door & front steps replaced, foundation faced with concrete

SITE & RELATED STR. Small lot in 19 century small-scale residential neighborhood

STATEMENT

This little house is a good example of the saltbox form, a type relatively rare in Davenport today. The symmetrical treatment of the front and chimney placement suggests the lingering influence of the Greek Revival style.

It is difficult to determine the first occupant of this building because of its modest size and apparently early construction date. Early owners included Johann Putzier (Pre-1884) and Sophie Sass and her descendants (1885 to 1913).
