## **NATIONAL REGISTER CRITERIA STATEMENT (if applicable)**

The Gilbert Hadley Three-Decker possesses integrity of location, design, setting, materials, workmanship, feeling and association. It is significant for its association with a middle-class residential district that extended westward from downtown Worcester in the late 19th century in the Piedmont area. It is also a remarkably well-preserved and unusually detailed example of Stick style three-decker architecture, particularly notable for its unusual array of porches. The Hadley Three-Decker thus meets criteria A and C of the National Register of Historic Places on the local level.

## **ARCHITECTURAL SIGNIFICANCE Describe important architectural features and evaluate in terms of other buildings within the community.**

Architecturally, 31 Russell Street is an unusually well-preserved three-decker, remarkable for its extensive array of multi-tiered porches, a display of Stick style ornament unparalleled in Worcester. The building has the characteristic side-hall plan with a side-wall jog. The asymmetrical, three-bay facade contains an end-bay entry with a double-leaf, panelled door. The hip roof contains an unusual shed dormer centered on the front slope. The roof cornice overhang has regularly spaced, decorative brackets. Windows have 1/1 and 2/2 sash, with simple surrounds. Most notable is the extent of porchwork on the side-elevations of the building. A single-story porch extends across the main facade, and wraps around the side wall, where it extends to full, three-tier height. From the opposite side wall an additional three-tier porch projects outward. The porches are supported by chamfered posts and contain stick work balustrades, friezes, and large cut brackets.

## **HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE Explain the role owners played in local or state history and how the building relates to the development of the community.**

The Hadley Three-Decker is located on the western edge of the middle-class residential neighborhood that developed west of Crown Hill in the late 19th century. The house was built ca. 1888, probably by the Hadley Company, carpenters and contractors, which listed its business location at neighboring 33 Russell Street, where Herman Hadley had his residence. The first known owner of 31 Russell Street was Gilbert S. Hadley, a carpenter, who also lived here. Residents in 1890 included William Pratt, an optician; Bernard Vassall, an insurance agent; and Walter Dodge, a clerk. Residents in 1900 included Addison March, a policeman; Walter March, a bookkeeper; G. March, a music teacher; George Battelle, a mason; and S.W. Linclon, a printer. By 1910, the house was owned by Florence S. Winslow. Residents included J. Archer Winslow, a pressman; Samuel Small, a harnessmaker, and Walter Bryson, a toolmaker. The Winslow family resided here through 1930. Other residents in 1930 included John F. McDermott, who ran the Refined School of Dance; George Stone, an insurance agent; and Edwin Stone, a machinist.

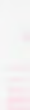
