


DESCRIPTION: (cont.) sidelights and transom covered over on 1st. fl. entrance; sidelights and corner lights remain on 2nd. fl. and have been decorated by painting then scraping patterns in wet paint; central hall has open string spiral stair w/ decorative brackets; S. 1st. fl. rm. has marbeled mantle w/ heavy pilasters and wide reeding; paneled window aprons; windows and doors have shouldered architrave as do all rms. downstairs; N. rm. retains same mantle design w/o marbleing and window aprons; mantle in W. rm. is simple w/simple pilasters; rm. also contains closed stairs w/winders; upstairs N. rm. has pronounced architrave on windows and doors; S. rm. has pedimented and pronounced window frames. Downstairs doors are 3'9" x 7'6"







Point A is located 40 ft. northeast of the northeast corner of the house. Beginning at point A, south 90' along a tree line 20' from the principal (east) facade to B, thence 80'west along a line marked by trees to C, thence north 90' along a line marked by trees to D, thence east 80' along a line marked by trees to the point of origin. The boundaries were chosen to encompass the house and its domestic-related space as defined by trees; there are no fences or other boundary markings. No contributing outbuildings.

The nominated area contains one contributing building.
