26. Significance The Henderson House is a good example of the Dutch Colonial style, as interpreted in Western Kentucky. It is the only structure in the community which exhibits the Dutch Colonial influence, and one of few constructed in the region.

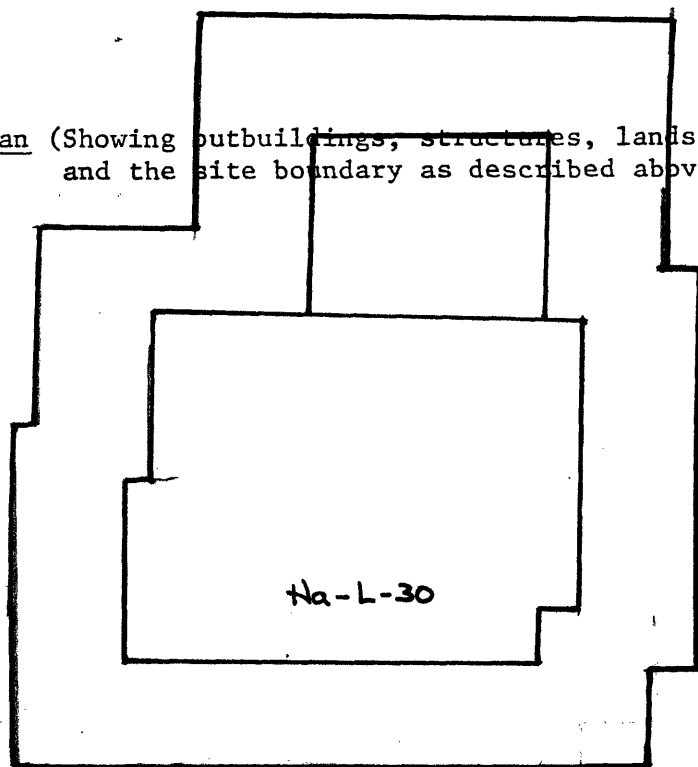
