20. Significance Built circa 1850 by Dr. D. W. Parrish, this excellently detailed Greek Revival house relates most closely in form and detail to a nearby group of houses situated on the Lexington Pike in Fayette County. An elaborate acanthus leaf motif is predominant in the interior woodwork. Dr. Parrish was one of the group of famous breeders of Clark County shorthorn cattle.
