

Physical Description

A variety of textures and materials, asymmetrical arrangement of certain elements and fenestration of differing sizes combine to create a rather lively effect which offsets to a degree the large size of this structure. The characteristic tile hipped roof with flared overhanging eaves caps the two-story house which is faced with brick. At the south end of the front elevation a two-story porch appears, the lower story remains enclosed as designed and the second floor, originally open, is now enclosed. square entrance portico with brick piers and a gable roof supported by large brackets dominates the front elevation. In the angle formed by the porticos, a long roofless porch extends across the front elevation. This porch is outlined by a low brick wall with balusters of simple brick piers and cast stone coping. The north elevation is especially dramatic with what appears to be a narrow three-story projecting bay, capped by gable roof, containing the side entrance. Panels of stucco with half-timbering enrich the panels between the floors of windows; similar decorative effects appear on the two-story porch wing of the front elevation. The front door features a multi-paned window and multi-paned transom and sidelights. Windows of varying sizes and types appear in this house, the most typical are sash windows with ten-over-one-lights.

Statement of Significance

The Fox House at 1303 S. Olive is another ca. 1910 Theo Sanders residential design in the city of Pine Bluff. This Craftsman influenced house features a variety of textures and materials in the use of tile, stucco, brick and pseudo half-timbering. An asymmetrical arrangement of doors and windows offsets the unusually large size of the Fox House. The house is two-stories and covered by a tile hipped roof with flared overhanging eaves. The dominant feature of the front elevation is a large gable roof entrance portico. This porch is supported by brick piers and large brackets. Situated on a well landscaped corner lot in a quiet residential section of Pine Bluff, the Fox House is a dominant structure in its neighborhood.
