STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The primary significance of Okiokilepe Fishpond is that it is virtually the only fishpond left in the Pearl Harbor area where once there were many, many more. The fishponds of Pearl Marbor must once have rivaled those of Kaneohe Bay on windward Oahu in their importance. Yet today Okiokilepe is the only one of these remaining in good condition in leeward Oahu and near the urban center of Honolulu.

Okiokilepe also derives much of its significance from its manner of construction, being built of stacked coral chunks instead of the stone faced and filled walls of fishponds in Kaneohe Bay.

The acceptance of Okiokilepe to the National Register would encourage the Department of the Navy to take measures to preserve the pond and, perhaps, open it to the public.
