DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Byron Howes House is an excellent example of the towered mode of the Italian Villa style of architecture popularized by Andrew Jackson Downing. The two story house is of wood frame construction with sheathed clapboard siding. It is constructed on an L shaped plan with a tower at the intersection of the L. The third story of the tower is defined by a secondary cornice and paired, round arched, double hung windows.

Decorative brackets appear on the bay windows, porches and roof eaves. The peaked gables are decorated with scroll sawed bargeboards. A porch with beveled columns fronts the residence.

An iron fence set on a low stone base defines the grounds and house. The landscaping of this large corner lot carries out the Downing philosophy of creating a total environment.

1868-1870-present

SPECIFIC DATES

The Byron Howes House constructed from 1868-1870, is significant due to its association with one of Hastings earliest and most influential settlers and the architectural style that it represents.

BUILDER/ARCHITECT

Byron Howes was born in Putnams County, New York on March 9, 1833, He came to Hastings, Minnesota in 1856. He was a banker and established the Farmers and Trades Bank of Hastings in 1872. Howes then went on to become one of the founders and the largest stockholder in the German American Bank of St. Paul, Minnesota.

He held many public offices in the City of Hastings including City Alderman, City Treasurer, Deputy County Treasurer and School Board Treasurer. He died April 6, 1886 at the age of 53.

The home Byron Howes constructed is an excellent example of the Towered mode of the Italian Villa style of architecture popularized by Andrew Jackson Downing. For over a century the house and surrounding grounds have retained their original integrity.
